

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3442, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MR. SCHRADER OF OREGON**

Page 6, after line 6, add the following:

1 **SEC. 3. REQUIRING REDUCTION OF PAY OF MEMBERS OF**  
2 **CONGRESS IF GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN OC-**  
3 **CURS.**

4 (a) REDUCTION OF PAY FOR EACH DAY OF GOVERN-  
5 MENT SHUTDOWN.—

6 (1) IN GENERAL.—If on any day during a year  
7 a Government shutdown is in effect, the annual rate  
8 of pay applicable under section 601(a) of the Legis-  
9 lative Reorganization Act of 1946 (2 U.S.C. 4501)  
10 with respect to each Member of Congress for the  
11 year shall be reduced by an amount equal to the  
12 product of—

13 (A) an amount equal to one day’s worth of  
14 pay under such annual rate; and

15 (B) the number of 24-hour periods during  
16 which the Government shutdown is in effect.

17 (2) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This subsection shall  
18 apply with respect to days occurring after the date  
19 of the regularly scheduled general election for Fed-  
20 eral office held in November 2016.

1 (b) DETERMINATION OF GOVERNMENT SHUT-  
2 DOWN.—For purposes of this section, a Government shut-  
3 down shall be considered to be in effect if—

4 (1) there is a lapse in appropriations for any  
5 Federal agency or department as a result of a fail-  
6 ure to enact a regular appropriations bill or con-  
7 tinuing resolution; or

8 (2) the Federal Government defaults on pay-  
9 ments on the national debt as a result of a failure  
10 to raise or suspend the statutory debt limit under  
11 section 3101 of title 31, United States Code.

12 (c) MEMBER OF CONGRESS DEFINED.—In this sec-  
13 tion, the term “Member of Congress” means an individual  
14 serving in a position under subparagraph (A), (B), or (C)  
15 of section 601(a) of the Legislative Reorganization Act of  
16 1946 (2 U.S.C. 4501).
