

**AMENDMENT TO H. CON. RES. 34, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MS. SCHWARTZ OF PENNSYLVANIA**

Section 101(1)(A) is amended by increasing the recommended levels of Federal revenues for fiscal years 2012 through 2021 by the following amounts: for fiscal year 2012: \$1,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2013: \$13,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2014: \$45,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2015: \$63,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2016: \$73,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2017: \$82,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2018: \$102,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2019: \$112,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2020: \$131,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2021: \$150,000,000,000.

Section 101(1)(B) is amended by reducing the amounts by which the aggregate levels of Federal revenues for fiscal years 2012 through 2021 should be changed: for fiscal year 2012: \$1,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2013: \$13,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2014: \$45,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2015: \$63,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2016: \$73,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2017: \$82,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2018: \$102,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2019:

\$112,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2020:
\$131,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2021:
\$150,000,000,000.

Paragraph (11) of section 102 (Health (550)) is amended by increasing new budget authority and outlays for fiscal years 2012 through 2021 as follows: for fiscal year 2012: \$1,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2013: \$13,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2014: \$45,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2015: \$63,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2016: \$73,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2017: \$82,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2018: \$102,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2019: \$112,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2020: \$131,000,000,000; for fiscal year 2021: \$150,000,000,000.
