1	SEC. 1762. STUDY ON VIABILITY OF SEAWATER MINING FOR
2	CRITICAL MINERALS.
3	(a) FINDING.—The Congress finds that—
4	(1) extracting minerals from seawater has the
5	potential to provide a domestic source for minerals
6	that are critical to the defense industrial base of the
7	United States, which would reduce the dependence
8	of the United States on imports of the minerals
9	while strengthening the national security and the de-
10	fense industrial base of the United States;
11	(2) the cost of extracting uranium from sea-
12	water has dropped significantly to nearly \$400 per
13	kilogram; and
14	(3) extracting uranium from seawater is an en-
15	vironmentally friendly, emerging technology solution
16	that has the potential to transform how uranium is
17	extracted.
18	(b) Study.—Within 60 days after the date of the en-
19	actment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense in consulta-

- 1 tion with the head of any other relevant Federal agency
- 2 and relevant stakeholders, shall conduct a study of the via-
- 3 bility of extracting minerals, such as uranium, that are
- 4 critical to the defense industrial base of the United States,
- 5 from seawater.
- 6 (c) Report.—Within 1 year after the date of the en-
- 7 actment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense shall submit
- 8 to the Committee on Armed Services and the Committee
- 9 on Science, Space, and Technology of the House of Rep-
- 10 resentatives and the Committee on Armed Services and
- 11 the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the
- 12 Senate a written report which contains the results of the
- 13 study required by subsection (b).
