To prohibit the government-sponsored enterprises from offering any new products during the term of any conservatorship or receivership of such enterprises.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "GSE Risk and Activi-
- 5 ties Limitation Act of 2024".

1SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON NEW PRODUCTS DURING CON-2SERVATORSHIP OR RECEIVERSHIP.

3 (a) PROHIBITION.—Notwithstanding any other provi-4 sion of law, during the term of any conservatorship or re-5 ceivership of a government-sponsored enterprise, the en-6 terprise may not offer or make available any product of 7 the enterprise that was not initially offered or made avail-8 able during a period when the enterprise was not under 9 conservatorship or receivership.

10 (b) GSEs.—For purposes of this section, the term
11 "government-sponsored enterprise" means—

(1) the Federal National Mortgage Association;
(2) the Federal Home Loan Mortgage Corporation;

15 (3) the Federal Home Loan Banks; and

(4) the institutions of the Farm Credit System,
including the Agricultural Credit Bank, the Farm
Credit Banks, and the Federal Agricultural Mortgage Corporation.
