

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-33
OFFERED BY MR. AUSTIN SCOTT OF GEORGIA

At the end of subtitle D of title XII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 12___. UNITED STATES-POLAND MILITARY SPACE CO-**
2 **OPERATION PROGRAM.**

3 (a) **ESTABLISHMENT.**—The Secretary of Defense
4 shall establish a United States-Republic of Poland Mil-
5 itary Space Cooperation Program.

6 (b) **PURPOSE.**—The purpose of the program shall be
7 to strengthen military cooperation between the United
8 States and the Republic of Poland in support of space-
9 enabled military operations, resilience, and preparedness.

10 (c) **ACTIVITIES.**—The program may support the fol-
11 lowing activities:

12 (1) Analysis and assessment of threats to mili-
13 tary space capabilities and supporting infrastruc-
14 ture.

15 (2) Development and dissemination of oper-
16 ational concepts, doctrine, tactics, techniques, proce-
17 dures, and best practices relating to resilient posi-
18 tioning, navigation, and timing capabilities, satellite

1 communications, space domain awareness, and
2 space-enabled military operations.

3 (3) Collection, analysis, and dissemination of
4 operational lessons learned from contemporary con-
5 flicts regarding the employment, protection, and re-
6 silience of military space capabilities.

7 (4) Military exercises, training events, simula-
8 tions, wargames, personnel exchanges, and other co-
9 operative military activities involving personnel of
10 the United States and the Republic of Poland.

11 (5) Collaboration, as appropriate, with commer-
12 cial entities, federally funded research and develop-
13 ment centers, academic institutions, and other orga-
14 nizations on matters relating to military space oper-
15 ations, space resilience, satellite communications, po-
16 sitioning, navigation, and timing capabilities, and re-
17 lated emerging technologies.

18 (6) Such other activities as the Secretary of De-
19 fense determines necessary to advance the purposes
20 of the program.

21 (d) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date
22 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense
23 shall submit to the congressional defense committees a re-
24 port describing—

25 (1) plans for implementation of the program;

1 (2) anticipated contributions of the United
2 States and the Republic of Poland;

3 (3) opportunities to incorporate operational les-
4 sons learned from the conflict in Ukraine into mili-
5 tary space cooperation activities under the program;
6 and

7 (4) any legislative or policy recommendations
8 necessary to support the activities of the program.
