

**AMENDMENT TO**  
**RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-33**  
**OFFERED BY MR. AUSTIN SCOTT OF GEORGIA**

At the end of subtitle B of title X, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . SENSE OF CONGRESS ON NAMING A FUTURE**  
2 **NAVAL VESSEL USS SHANGRI-LA.**

3 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds the following:

4 (1) The April 18, 1942, Doolittle Raid against  
5 the Japanese homeland was one of the most daring  
6 and consequential operations of World War II, dem-  
7 onstrating American resolve during a critical period  
8 of the war.

9 (2) Following the raid, President Franklin D.  
10 Roosevelt, when asked where the aircraft had origi-  
11 nated, famously replied that they had come from  
12 “Shangri-La”, a reference that helped protect oper-  
13 ational security and became permanently associated  
14 with the raid and its participants.

15 (3) The Secretary of the Navy subsequently  
16 named the aircraft carrier USS Shangri-La (CV-  
17 38), which served with distinction during World War  
18 II, the Cold War, and the Vietnam War.

1           (4) The legacy of the Doolittle Raiders, USS  
2           Shangri-La (CV-38), and the generations of sailors  
3           and aviators who served aboard that vessel rep-  
4           resents an enduring example of courage, innovation,  
5           and determination in the defense of the United  
6           States.

7           (b) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con-  
8           gress that the Secretary of the Navy should give favorable  
9           consideration to naming a future naval vessel USS  
10          Shangri-La in honor of the Doolittle Raiders and the  
11          proud service of USS Shangri-La (CV-38).
