Amendment to Rules Committee Print 115–70 Offered by Mrs. Torres of California

At the end of subtitle F of title XII, add the following new section:

1 SEC. ____. DIRECTOR OF NATIONAL INTELLIGENCE AND FBI 2 REVIEW.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Director of National Intel-4 ligence and the Director of the Federal Bureau of Inves-5 tigation shall conduct a review to determine whether items 6 that are listed in subsection (b), subsequent to exportation 7 from the United States, have been diverted to individuals 8 or entities that are engaged in narcotics trafficking or ter-9 rorism.

(b) ITEMS COVERED.—The items described in this
subsection are items included in category I, II, or III of
the United States Munitions List, as in effect on May 17,
2018, and designated as—

14 (1) significant military equipment;

15 (2) components, parts, accessories, or attach-16 ments of significant military equipment;

17 (3) flame throwers specifically designed or18 modified for military application; or

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(4) apparatuses or devices for launching or de livering ordnance.

3 (c) REPORT.—Not later than 360 days after the date 4 of the enactment of this Act, the Director of National In-5 telligence shall provide a report describing the results of 6 the review conducted pursuant to subsection (a) to the 7 congressional defense committees, the Committee on For-8 eign Relations of the Senate, and the Committee on For-9 eign Affairs of the House of Representatives.

(d) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this section shall be construed as an authorization for the Intelligence Community to conduct surveillance activities targeting United States persons prohibited by Executive
Order 12333.

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
