

AMENDMENT

OFFERED BY MRS. MCIVER OF NEW JERSEY

Insert at the appropriate place in the bill the following:

1 SEC. _____. (a) None of the funds appropriated or
2 otherwise made available to the Department of Homeland
3 Security by this Act may be used to effectuate an appre-
4 hension, arrest, interview, request for identification,
5 search, or surveillance for the purposes of immigration en-
6 forcement at a sensitive location.

7 (b) In this section, the term “sensitive location”
8 means all of the physical space located within 1,000 feet
9 of—

10 (1) any medical or mental healthcare facility,
11 including any hospital, health care practitioner’s of-
12 fice, accredited health clinic, vaccination or testing
13 site, or emergent or urgent care facility, or commu-
14 nity health center;

15 (2) any public or private school (including
16 preschools, primary schools, secondary schools, and
17 postsecondary schools, any site of an early childhood
18 education program, any other institution of learning,
19 such as vocational or trade schools, and any other

1 site where individuals who are unemployed or under-
2 employed may apply for or receive workforce train-
3 ing;

4 (3) any school bus or school bus stop during pe-
5 riods when school children are present on the bus or
6 at the stop;

7 (4) any recreational facility for children, such
8 as playgrounds and formal recreational facilities;

9 (5) any childcare-focused facility, including
10 child care centers, before or after school care cen-
11 ters, foster care facilities, and group homes for chil-
12 dren;

13 (6) any location where disaster or emergency
14 response and relief is being provided by Federal,
15 State, or local entities, such as the distribution of
16 emergency supplies, food, and water; any place of
17 temporary shelter, any place along an evacuation
18 route, and any site where registration for disaster-
19 related assistance or family reunification is taking
20 place;

21 (7) any location of any organization that assists
22 children, pregnant women, victims of crime or abuse,
23 or individuals with significant mental or physical
24 disabilities, including domestic violence shelters,
25 child advocacy centers, facilities that serve disabled

1 persons, drug or alcohol counseling and treatment
2 facilities, rape crisis centers, supervised visitation
3 centers, family justice centers, victims' services pro-
4 viders, and community-based organizations providing
5 social services, or provides disaster or emergency so-
6 cial services and assistance, or services for individ-
7 uals experiencing homelessness, including food
8 banks, pantries, or other establishments distributing
9 food, and shelters;

10 (8) any church, synagogue, mosque, or other
11 place of worship or religious study, such as buildings
12 rented for the purpose of religious services, or a
13 temporary facility or location where such activities
14 are taking place;

15 (9) any sites of a funeral, graveside ceremony,
16 wedding, or any site where other religious or civil
17 ceremonies or observances are occurring;

18 (10) any site during the occurrence of a public
19 demonstration, such as a march, rally, or parade;

20 (11) any Federal, State, or local courthouse, in-
21 cluding the office of an individual's legal counsel or
22 representative, and a probation office;

23 (12) any congressional district office;

24 (13) any Social Security office;

1 (14) any public assistance offices, including lo-
2 cations where individuals may apply for or receive
3 unemployment compensation or report violations of
4 labor and employment laws; The indoor or outdoor
5 premises of a department of motor vehicles;

6 (15) a polling place, including any building or
7 infrastructure where voting takes place during an
8 election;

9 (16) a labor union hall or any other union-oper-
10 ated building or office where registered applicants
11 are referred in rotation to jobs;

12 (17) any public library; or

13 (18) any other location specified by the Sec-
14 retary of Homeland Security for purposes of this
15 section.
