Page 310, insert after line 10 the following:

1 **Subtitle G—Military Voting**
2 **Assistance**

3 **SEC. 661. FACILITATING COLLECTION AND PROVISION OF**
4 **VOTING INFORMATION FOR ABSENT MILI-**
5 **TARY AND OVERSEAS VOTERS.**

6 (a) INFORMATION FOR ABSENT VOTERS.—Section
7 101(b)(5) of the Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absen-
8 tee Voting Act (52 U.S.C. 20301(b)(5)) is amended—

9 (1) by striking “and (B)” and inserting “(B)”;
10 and

11 (2) by striking the semicolon at the end and in-
12 serting the following: “, and (C) to the extent prac-
13 ticable, descriptive material on State registration
14 and voting procedures applicable to uniformed serv-
15 ices voters voting at home;”.

16 (b) PROVISION OF INFORMATION.—Section 101(b) of
17 such Act (52 U.S.C. 20301(b)) is amended—

18 (1) by striking “and” at the end of paragraph
19 (10);

1 (2) by striking the period at the end of para-
2 graph (11) and inserting “; and”; and

3 (3) by adding at the end the following new
4 paragraph:

5 “(12) after consultation with the Administrator
6 of General Services, convey to the Administrator of
7 General Services such information as may be nec-
8 essary to facilitate the ability of vote.gov to include
9 appropriate and accurate information relating to the
10 times, places, and manner of registering to vote and
11 voting in elections for Federal office.”.

12 (c) USE OF FUNDS TO CARRY OUT ALL RESPON-
13 SIBILITIES OF SECRETARY OF DEFENSE UNDER UNI-
14 FORMED AND OVERSEAS CITIZENS ABSENTEE VOTING
15 ACT.—Section 101(d) of such Act (52 U.S.C. 20301(d))
16 is amended by striking “subsection (b)(10)” and inserting
17 “subsection (b)”.

18 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
19 this section shall apply with respect to elections held in
20 2024 or any succeeding year.
