5	(b) Defense Institution Capacity Building.—

12	"(E) An evaluation of political, social, eco-
13	nomic, diplomatic, and historical factors, if any

16	ness of the program.
17	"(F) An assessment of the sustainability of
18	support to be provided to foreign countries par-
19	ticipating in the program.

23	United States assistance to be provided under
24	the program.".

1	(c) Foreign Security Forces Capacity Build-
2	ING.—Section 333(e) of title 10, United States Code, is

5	"(8) An evaluation of political, social, economic,
6	diplomatic, and historical factors, if any, of the for-
7	eign country that may impair or inhibit the effective-
3	ness of the program.".
