At the end of subtitle A of title XII, add the following new section:

11	the period beginning on September 11, 2001, and ending

15	(1) Afghanistan.
16	(2) Iraq.
17	(3) Yemen.
18	(4) Nigeria.

1	(5) Mali.
2	(6) Chad.
3	(7) Somalia.
4	(8) The Philippines.
5	(9) Any other country as determined by the
6	Secretary of Defense.
7	(c) Matters to Be Included.—The report re-
8	quired under subsection (a) shall include the following:
9	(1) Lessons learned and best practices with re-
10	spect to such security cooperation programs and ac-
11	tivities of the Department of Defense.
12	(2) Relevant recommendations for future secu-
13	rity cooperation programs and activities of the De-
14	partment of Defense.
15	(3) Recommendations for monitoring and eval-
16	uation metrics for future security cooperation pro-
17	grams and activities of the Department of Defense.
18	(4) Evaluation of the efficacy of the assessment
19	tools used by the Department of Defense and other
20	relevant security cooperation agencies with respect
21	to such security cooperation programs and activities
22	of the Department of Defense for purposes of meas-
23	uring improvements made by the forces of the for-
24	eign countries specified in subsection (b).
25	(d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

6	(B) the Committee on Foreign Relations of
7	the Senate and the Committee on Foreign Af-

9	(2) Security Cooperation Programs and
10	ACTIVITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE.—
11	The term "security cooperation programs and activi-
12	ties of the Department of Defense" has the meaning
13	given such term in section 301(7) of title 10, United
14	States Code.
