12	(C) in section 1712—
13	(i) by striking subsections (a) and (b);
14	(ii) by redesignating subsections (c),
15	(d), (e), and (f) as subsections (a), (b), (c),
16	and (d), respectively; and
17	(iii) in subsection (a), as redesignated
18	by subparagraph (B)—

1	(I) by striking "Dental appli-
2	ances" and inserting "The Secretary
3	may furnish dentures, dental appli-
4	ances"; and
5	(II) by striking "to be furnished
6	by the Secretary under this section
7	may be procured by the Secretary"
8	and inserting "under this section and
9	may procure such appliances"; and
10	(D) by striking section 2062.
11	(2) Phased eligibility.—The amendments
12	made by paragraph (1) shall apply as follows:
13	(A) In the case of an individual who is eli-
14	gible for dental services and appliances fur-
15	nished by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs
16	under chapter 17 of title 38, United States
17	Code, on the date of the enactment of this Act,
18	beginning on the date of the enactment of this
19	Act.
20	(B) In the case of a veteran who is not so
21	eligible on the date of the enactment of this Act
22	and who is described in paragraph (1) or (2) of
23	subsection (a) of section 1705 of such title, be-
24	ginning on the date that is one year after the
25	date of the enactment of this Act.

1	(C) In the case of a veteran who is not so
2	eligible on the date of the enactment of this Act
3	and who is described in paragraph (3) or (4) of
4	subsection (a) of section 1705 of such title, be-
5	ginning on the date that is two years after the
6	date of the enactment of this Act.
7	(D) In the case of a veteran who is not so
8	eligible on the date of the enactment of this Act
9	and who is described in paragraph (5) or (6) of
10	subsection (a) of section 1705 of such title, be-
11	ginning on the date that is three years after the
12	date of the enactment of this Act.
13	(E) In the case of a veteran who is not so
14	eligible on the date of the enactment of this Act
15	and who is described in paragraph (7) or (8) of
16	subsection (a) of section 1705 of such title, be-
17	ginning on the date that is four years after the
18	date of the enactment of this Act.
19	(b) Conforming Amendments.—Title 38, United
20	States Code, is further amended—
21	(1) in section 1525(a), by striking "medicines
22	under section 1712(d)" and inserting "medicines
23	under section 1712(b)"; and
