At the appropriate place in subtitle A of title XVIII, insert the following:

1 SEC. ____. LIST OF HIGHLY DANGEROUS FOREIGN COUN 2 TRIES.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days after the 4 date of the enactment of this Act, and as appropriate 5 thereafter, the President shall identify any foreign country 6 in which the country or any part thereof is highly dangerous, based on the potential for violence and armed con-7 flict in the country or any part thereof, or the conditions 8 in the country pose a grave threat to the health and safety 9 10 of United States persons living there, and there is a significant possibility that United States persons visiting or 11 12 residing in the country or part thereof will need to be evac-13 uated.

(b) REFERENCE.—A foreign country or part identified by the President pursuant to subsection (a) shall be
designated as a "Highly Dangerous Foreign Country" for
purposes of this section.

(c) REGISTRATION SYSTEM FOR UNITED STATES
 PERSONS VISITING OR RESIDING IN HIGHLY DANGEROUS
 FOREIGN COUNTRIES.—

4 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of State shall
5 require a United States person visiting or residing
6 in, or intending to visit or reside in, a Highly Dan7 gerous Foreign Country to register with the Depart8 ment of State under existing protocols and to meet
