## AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119–8

## OFFERED BY MR. SHERMAN OF CALIFORNIA

At appropriate place in subtitle C of title XXXI, insert the following:

1	SEC. 31 REQUIREMENTS FOR TRANSFER OF CERTAIN
2	UNITED STATES NUCLEAR TECHNOLOGY.
3	(a) Prohibition.—The President may not provide
4	authorization to transfer any nuclear reactor, equipment,
5	or technology to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia by a foreign
6	government or foreign person unless the President cer-
7	tifies to the appropriate congressional committees that
8	Saudi Arabia—
9	(1) has signed and implemented an Additional
10	Protocol to its Comprehensive Safeguards Agree-
11	ment with the International Atomic Energy Agency;
12	and
13	(2) does not have, is not acquiring or attempt-
14	ing to acquire, and is not building or attempting to
15	build, nuclear enrichment or reprocessing facilities,
16	including enrichment and reprocessing facilities de-
17	scribed in subsection (b).

(b) Nuclear Enrichment and Reprocessing Fa-
CILITIES DESCRIBED.—For the purposes of subsection
(a), nuclear enrichment and reprocessing facilities include
any installations or equipment that can—
(1) increase the ratio of uranium-235 to that
of the total uranium in question;
(2) chemically separate nuclear material from
fission products, following dissolution of spent fuel;
(3) create fuel for nuclear reactors; or
(4) produce special fissionable material as de-
fined in Article XX of the statute of the Inter-
national Atomic Energy Agency.
(c) Appropriate Congressional Committees De-
FINED.—In this section, the term "appropriate congres-
sional committees" means—
(1) the Committee on Foreign Affairs and the
Committee on Armed Services of the House of Rep-
resentatives; and
(2) the Committee on Foreign Relations and
the Committee on Armed Services of the Senate.
