

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119-33**  
**OFFERED BY MR. SHERMAN OF CALIFORNIA**

At the end of subtitle B of title XVII of division A,  
add the following:

1 **SEC. 17\_\_ . PROHIBITION ON EXPORTS OF CRUDE OIL, GASO-**  
2 **LINE, AND DIESEL FUEL DURING PERIOD OF**  
3 **MILITARY OPERATIONS AGAINST IRAN.**

4 Section 101 of division O of the Consolidated Appro-  
5 priations Act, 2016 (42 U.S.C. 6212a) is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (b), by striking “subsections  
7 (c) and (d)” and inserting “subsections (c), (d), and  
8 (f)”; and

9 (2) by adding at the end the following:

10 “(f) **ADDITIONAL EXCEPTION.—**

11 “(1) **IN GENERAL.—**Notwithstanding any other  
12 provision of law (including the other provisions of  
13 this section), except as provided in paragraph (2),  
14 the export of crude oil, gasoline, and diesel fuel shall  
15 be prohibited during the period beginning on the  
16 date of the enactment of this subsection and ending  
17 on the date on which the President—

1           “(A) declares that military operations  
2           against Iran which began in March 2026 have  
3           ceased; and

4           “(B) determines and certifies to Congress  
5           that the Strait of Hormuz is fully open and  
6           global shipping through the Strait has resumed;  
7           and

8           “(2) WAIVER.—In the case of a proposed ex-  
9           port of crude oil, the President may waive the prohi-  
10          bition in paragraph (1) if the President determines  
11          that crude oil cannot be efficiently refined in the  
12          United States. If the President issues a waiver  
13          under this paragraph, the President shall issue a li-  
14          cense for the export of crude oil from the United  
15          States pursuant to such waiver and further require  
16          that such crude oil is to be refined abroad and im-  
17          ported back into the United States.”.
