At the end of subtitle G of title V, insert the following:

1	SEC. 5 PROVISION OF SECURE FIREARM STORAGE IN-
2	FORMATION TO TRANSITIONING MEMBERS
3	OF THE ARMED FORCES.
4	(a) Establishment.—Not later than six months
5	after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
6	of Defense shall establish rules under which each member
7	of a covered Armed Force shall be provided with informa-
8	tion on the secure storage of firearms in the home before
9	the member transitions from active duty service in the
10	Armed Forces.
11	(b) SECURE STORAGE INFORMATION.—The secure
12	storage information provided to transitioning service mem-
13	bers under (a) shall include—
14	(1) that firearms should be stored unloaded, out
15	of the reach of children and other persons without
16	authorized access, and separately from ammunition;
17	(2) that stored firearms should be secured with
18	a locking device;

1	(3) information about the importance of secure
2	storage, including data on the risks of unsecured
3	firearms and the benefits of securely stored firearms
4	in relation to firearm suicide, firearm homicide and
5	assault, school firearm violence, unintentional shoot-
6	ings, and theft; and
7	(4) guidance on the most secure types of stor-
8	age devices, including the advantages of gun safes
9	and lock boxes compared to trigger and cable locks.
10	(c) COVERED ARMED FORCE.—In this section, the
11	term "covered Armed Force" means the any of the fol-
12	lowing:
13	(1) The Army.
14	(2) The Navy.
15	(3) The Marine Corps.
16	(4) The Air Force.
17	(5) The Space Force.
