

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-**

**OFFERED BY MS. SLOTKIN OF MICHIGAN**

Add at the end the following:

1 **SEC. 18. GRANT PROGRAM FOR TRAINING OF PHYSICIANS**

2 **ON PFAS.**

3 Part P of title III of the Public Health Service Act  
4 (42 U.S.C. 280g et seq.) is amended by adding at the end  
5 the following:

6 **“SEC. 399V-7. GRANT PROGRAM FOR TRAINING OF PHYSI-**  
7 **CIANS ON PFAS.**

8 “(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall award  
9 grants to eligible entities for the purpose of developing  
10 courses for physicians or other medical practitioners to in-  
11 form such physicians and medical practitioners about the  
12 impact of perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substance ex-  
13 posure on health outcomes and best practices for patients  
14 who have been exposed to such substances.

15 “(b) ELIGIBLE ENTITIES.—To be eligible to receive  
16 a grant under this section, and entity shall—

17 “(1) be—

1           “(A) a national or State medical organiza-  
2           tion or other organization that provides edu-  
3           cational courses to health care providers; or

4           “(B) an institution of medical research or  
5           a clinical researcher at such an institution of  
6           medical research;

7           “(2) have expertise in clinical conditions or dis-  
8           eases that are related or exacerbated by  
9           perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substance expo-  
10          sure, experience in environmental health, and other  
11          expertise and experience as the Secretary determines  
12          appropriate;

13          “(3) commit to gathering input from patients  
14          and clinicians when developing the training courses,  
15          as the Secretary determines appropriate; and

16          “(4) submit an application to the Secretary at  
17          such time, in such manner, and containing such in-  
18          formation as the Secretary may require.

19          “(c) REPORTING.—

20                 “(1) GRANTEE REPORTING TO THE SEC-  
21                 RETARY.—Each recipient of a grant under this sec-  
22                 tion shall annually report to the Secretary, in a form  
23                 and manner determined by the Secretary, on train-  
24                 ing materials developed through use of funds award-  
25                 ed under the grant. Each such report shall include

1 any findings or recommendations that the grantees  
2 have determined should be included in physician or  
3 medical practitioner training.

4 “(2) HHS DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION.—  
5 Each year, not later than 90 days after receiving the  
6 reports from grant recipients under paragraph (1),  
7 the Secretary shall disseminate to the public a sum-  
8 mary of findings and recommendations that are in-  
9 cluded in the material provided under such para-  
10 graph (1).

11 “(d) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term ‘PFAS’  
12 means a perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl substance with  
13 at least one fully fluorinated carbon atom.

14 “(e) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—To  
15 carry out this section, there is authorized to be appro-  
16 priated \$500,000 for the period of fiscal years 2021  
17 through 2025, to remain available until expended.”.
