OFFERED BY MS. SLOTKIN OF MICHIGAN

At the end of subtitle B of title III, insert the following:

1 SEC. 3___. PUBLIC AVAILABILITY OF CERTAIN INFORMATION
2 RELATING TO DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE
3 PFAS CLEANUP ACTIVITIES.

4 The Secretary of Defense shall make publicly available
5 on the website required under section 331(b) of the
6 National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2020
7 (Public Law 116–92; 10 U.S.C. 2701 note) timely and
8 regularly updated information on the status and schedule
9 of the cleanup activities at sites where the Secretary has
10 obligated amounts for environmental restoration activities
11 to address the release of per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances
12 (in this section referred to as “PFAS”). Not later
13 than one year after the date of the enactment of this Act,
14 the Secretary shall ensure that the following information
15 is available on such website for each such site:

- 16 (1) A schedule of future off-base drinking water
17 sampling efforts and results of off-base drinking
18 water sampling for PFAS.

1 (2) The number of off-site private drinking
2 water wells in which the Department has detected
3 PFAS attributable to Department activities above a
4 Federal drinking water standard.

5 (3) A description of measures undertaken or
6 planned to mitigate the migration of PFAS-affected
7 groundwater from the site at levels above Federal
8 drinking water standards, including a schedule for
9 the implementation of such measures.

10 (4) The number of off-site private drinking
11 water wells for which alternative drinking water or
12 treatment has been provided to prevent the con-
13 sumption of PFAS-affected water above Federal
14 drinking water standards.

15 (5) The location of or link to the administrative
16 record and any site-related environmental restora-
17 tion documents of the site, including work plans, en-
18 vironmental reports, regulator comments, decision
19 documents, and public comments.

20 (6) The location of the restoration advisory
21 board document repository for the site or a link to
22 the community outreach website of the restoration
23 advisory board where documents such as public com-
24 ments, and records of community engagement meet-
25 ings and briefings are available.

- 1 (7) An estimate of the cost to complete and
- 2 schedule of the remediation of PFAS at the site.
