TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-8
OFFERED BY MR. SMITH OF NEW JERSEY

Add at the end the following:

1 **DIVISION H—HEIDI’S LAW**

2 **SEC. 12001. SHORT TITLE.**

3 This division may be cited as “Heidi’s Law”.

4 **SEC. 12002. INCLUSION OF TESTING FOR METHADONE USE**
5 **IN CERTAIN DRUG TESTING PROCEDURES.**

6 (a) REVISION OF MANDATORY GUIDELINES.—Not
7 later than 90 days after the date of enactment of this Act,
8 the Secretary of Health and Human Services shall revise
9 the Mandatory Guidelines for Federal Workplace Drug
10 Testing Programs, established pursuant to section 503(a)
11 of Public Law 100-71 (5 U.S.C. 7301 note), to expand
12 the opiate category on the list of substances authorized
13 for testing to include methadone.

14 (b) PUBLICATION OF NOTICE.—Upon completion of
15 the revision required under subsection (a), the Secretary
16 shall publish a final notice in the Federal Register of such
17 revision.

1 **SEC. 12003. INCLUSION OF METHADONE IN DEPARTMENT**
2 **OF TRANSPORTATION DRUG TESTS.**

3 Not later than 60 days after the final notice required
4 under section 12002(b) is published, the Secretary of
5 Transportation shall issue such regulations as are nec-
6 essary to update any regulations containing procedures for
7 transportation employee workplace drug and alcohol test-
8 ing programs to include testing for methadone use in
9 drug-testing panels, consistent with the Mandatory Guide-
10 lines for Federal Workplace Drug Testing Programs as
11 revised by the Secretary of Health and Human Services
12 under section 12002.

13 **SEC. 12004. TO COMPEL THE SECRETARY TO PERIODI-**
14 **CALLY UPDATE THE MANDATORY GUIDE-**
15 **LINES FOR FEDERAL WORKPLACE DRUG**
16 **TESTING.**

17 (a) IN GENERAL.—On an annual basis, the Secretary
18 of Health and Human Services shall review and if nec-
19 essary revise the Mandatory Guidelines for Federal Work-
20 place Drug Testing Programs, established pursuant to
21 section 503(a) of Public Law 100–71 (5 U.S.C. 7301
22 note), to expand the list of substances authorized for test-
23 ing to include any such drugs which may not have been
24 previously included, and which the Secretary believes
25 should be included.

1 (b) PUBLICATION OF NOTICE.—Upon completion of
2 the revision required under subsection (a), the Secretary
3 shall publish a final notice in the Federal Register of such
4 revision.

5 **SEC. 12005. INCLUSION OF NEWLY ESTABLISHED DRUGS IN**
6 **DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION DRUG**
7 **TESTS.**

8 Not later than 60 days after the final notice required
9 under section 12004(b) is published, the Secretary of
10 Transportation shall issue such regulations as are nec-
11 essary to update any regulations containing procedures for
12 transportation employee workplace drug and alcohol test-
13 ing programs to include testing for newly identified sub-
14 stances in drug-testing panels, consistent with the Manda-
15 tory Guidelines for Federal Workplace Drug Testing Pro-
16 grams as revised by the Secretary of Health and Human
17 Services under section 12004.
