## Amendment to Rules Comm. Print 118–10 Offered by Mr. Smith of New Jersey

At the end of subtitle E of title XII, add the following:

## SEC. \_. REPORT ON UNITED STATES PRESENCE IN THE HORN OF AFRICA AND RED SEA REGION. (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con gress that—

5 (1) increased United States engagement in the
6 Horn of Africa and Red Sea region has presented an
7 opportunity to build and strengthen security co8 operation with key partners there;

9 (2) Somaliland, with a port and airfield in 10 Berbera, occupies a pivotal geographic location in 11 the Horn of Africa, is adjacent to strategic maritime 12 routes in the Red Sea and Gulf of Aden, and could 13 contribute to United States military objectives given 14 the evolving security situation in the region;

(3) utilization of the port of Berbera as an access point to the Horn of Africa would provide flexibility with regards to the delivery of humanitarian
assistance in the Horn of Africa region and beyond.

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1 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date 2 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense, 3 in consultation with the Secretary of State and the heads 4 of other relevant Federal departments and agencies, shall 5 submit a classified report, along with an unclassified summary, to the appropriate congressional committees that 6 7 contains an assessment of the extent to which a sustained 8 United States Government presence in Somaliland 9 would-

10 (1) support United States policy focused on the
11 Red Sea corridor, the Indo-Pacific region, and the
12 Horn of Africa, including the promotion of conflict
13 avoidance and resolution;

14 (2) improve cooperation on counterterrorism
15 and intelligence sharing, including to degrade and
16 ultimately defeat the terrorist threat posed by Al17 Shabaab, the Islamic State in Somalia, and other
18 terrorist groups operating in Somalia;

19 (3) enhance cooperation on counter-trafficking,
20 including the trafficking of humans, wildlife, weap21 ons, and illicit goods;

22 (4) support trade and development;

23 (5) facilitate the distribution of humanitarian24 assistance in the Horn of Africa; and

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1	(6) counter the presence of the People's Repub-
2	lic of China (PRC) in the region, including by detail-
3	ing—
4	(A) the PRC's interest in access to port fa-
5	cilities in Djibouti, Mombasa, Massawa and
6	Assab;
7	(B) the PRC's role in fomenting unrest in
8	the Sool region of Somaliland; and
9	(C) the role played by the Republic of
10	China (Taiwan) in checking the PRC's engage-
11	ment with Somaliland.
12	(c) Appropriate Congressional Committees De-
13	FINED.—In subsection (b), the term "appropriate congres-
14	sional committees" means—
15	(1) the Committee on Armed Services of the
16	House of Representatives;
17	(2) the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the
18	House of Representatives;
19	(3) the Committee on Armed Services of the
20	Senate; and
21	(4) the Committee on Foreign Relations of the
22	Senate.

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
