

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118-**

**10**

**OFFERED BY MR. SMITH OF NEW JERSEY**

At the end of subtitle F of title X, insert the following:

**1 SEC. 10\_\_\_. REPORT ON BASIC UNDERWATER DEMOLITION/  
2 SEAL TRAINING PROGRAM.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the  
4 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the  
5 Navy shall submit to the Committees on Armed Services  
6 of the Senate and House or Representatives a report on  
7 the Basic Underwater Demolition/SEAL training program  
8 (in this section referred to as “BUD/S”) during the period  
9 beginning on the date of the induction of BUDS Class  
10 319 and ending on the date of completion of the most re-  
11 cently completed BUD/S class as of the date of the enact-  
12 ment of this Act. Such report shall include—

13 (1) the standards, metrics, training doctrine,  
14 purposes, and administration of BUD/S;

15 (2) the standards and practices governing med-  
16 ical care provide to candidates undergoing BUD/S  
17 training;

1           (3) the standards and qualifications informing  
2 the selection of instructors for BUD/S;

3           (4) the training pathway for candidates prior to  
4 induction for BUD/S;

5           (5) any changes governing training and screen-  
6 ing for candidates prior to induction;

7           (6) any changes regarding the composition,  
8 qualifications, and conduct of the instructor cadre at  
9 BUD/S;

10          (7) the policies regarding civilian participation  
11 in BUD/S, such as retired Navy personnel;

12          (8) any changes to policies regarding retired ci-  
13 vilian personnel participating in BUD/S instruction;

14          (9) all instances of candidates who died, or suf-  
15 fered serious injury necessitating separation from  
16 the Navy during BUD/S;

17          (10) policies set forth governing standard oper-  
18 ating procedures in the case of the death of a can-  
19 didate at BUD/S;

20          (11) accountability actions related to incidents  
21 that resulted in the death or serious injury of BUD/  
22 S candidates; and

23          (12) corrective actions implemented after the  
24 death or serious injury of BUD/S candidates.

1 (b) ACCOMPANYING DOCUMENT.—The Secretary of  
2 the Navy shall submit, with the report required under sub-  
3 section (a) accompanying documents outlining the stand-  
4 ards of conduct, training doctrine, instructor qualification,  
5 and medical care, used by Naval Special Warfare Com-  
6 mand to inform the training standards and provide oper-  
7 ational direction to BUD/S.
