At the end of subtitle C of title V, insert the following:

1 SEC. 5____. PROTECTIONS FOR MEMBERS OF THE ARMED 2 FORCES WHO REFUSE TO RECEIVE VACCINA 3 TIONS AGAINST COVID-19.

4 (a) CHARACTERIZATION OF DISCHARGE OR DIS-5 MISSAL.—

6 (1) PROHIBITION OF DISHONORABLE CHARAC7 TERIZATION.—The characterization of the discharge
8 or dismissal of a covered individual shall be honor9 able.

10 (2) UPGRADE.—In the case of a covered indi-11 vidual discharged or dismissed from the Armed 12 Forces before the date of the enactment of this Act, 13 the Secretary concerned shall upgrade the character-14 ization of such discharge or dismissal to honorable. 15 (b) PROHIBITION OF DENIAL OF RETIRED PAY AND BENEFITS.—No covered individual may be denied, solely 16 on the basis that such individual is a covered individual, 17 18 any $\mathbf{2}$

1 (1) retired or retainer pay; or 2 (2) benefit under a law administered by the 3 Secretary of Defense or the Secretary of Veterans Affairs (including post-9/11 educational assistance 4 5 under chapter 33 of title 38, United States Code). 6 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section: 7 (1) The term "covered individual" means an individual involuntarily separated from the Armed 8 9 Forces solely on the basis of the refusal of such indi-10 vidual to receive a vaccination against COVID-19. (2) The term "Secretary concerned" has the 11 12 meaning given that term in section 101 of title 10, 13 United States Code.
