

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-33
OFFERED BY MR. SMITH OF NEW JERSEY

At the end of subtitle E of title X, add the following
new section:

1 **SEC. 10___. REVIEW AND REPORT ON UAS ACTIVITY IN THE**
2 **VICINITY OF CRITICAL INSTALLATIONS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Inspector General of the De-
4 partment of Defense shall conduct a review of potential
5 foreign adversary connected unmanned aircraft system
6 (UAS) activity over critical military installations, vessels,
7 aircraft, and the homeland, and other matters.

8 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date
9 of the enactment of this Act, the Inspector General shall
10 submit to the relevant committees a report on—

11 (1) UAS activity over military installations in
12 the United States and abroad;

13 (2) UAS activity in close proximity to sensitive
14 national security installations;

15 (3) instances of UAS activity in the vicinity of
16 United States military and law enforcement vessels
17 and aircraft;

1 (4) the process for deploying counter-UAS sys-
2 tems to assist State and local law enforcement;

3 (5) instances where the Department of Defense
4 deployed counter-UAS systems to assist State and
5 local law enforcement;

6 (6) instances where the Department of Defense
7 received requests for counter-UAS assistance from
8 Installation Commanders;

9 (7) whether the Department of Defense possess
10 appropriate capabilities to supply all installations
11 with counter-UAS technology;

12 (8) whether Installation Commanders possess
13 the capability and authorities to address UAS incur-
14 sions to installations and in the immediate vicinity
15 of installations; and

16 (9) an analysis of near-peer actors who possess
17 the capabilities to conduct such activities.

18 (c) DEFINITION OF RELEVANT COMMITTEE.—In this
19 section, the term “relevant committees” means—

20 (1) the Committees on Armed Services of the
21 House of Representatives and the Senate;

22 (2) the Committee on Homeland Security of the
23 House of Representatives and the Committee on
24 Homeland Security and Government Affairs of the
25 Senate;

1 (3) the Committee on Transportation and In-
2 frastructure of the House of Representatives and the
3 Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transpor-
4 tation of the Senate;

5 (4) the Committee on the Judiciary of the
6 House of Representatives and the Committee on the
7 Judiciary of the Senate;

8 (5) the Permanent Select Committee on Intel-
9 ligence of the House of Representatives and the Se-
10 lect Committee on Intelligence of the Senate;

11 (6) the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the
12 House of Representatives and the Committee on
13 Foreign Relations of the Senate; and

14 (7) the Committee on Oversight and Account-
15 ability of the House of Representatives.

16 (d) FORM.—The report required under subsection (b)
17 shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include
18 a classified annex.
