

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-

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OFFERED BY MR. SMITH OF WASHINGTON

Strike section 1031.

At the end of subtitle A of title X, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 10 ____. FUNDING INCREASES AND REDUCTIONS.**

2 (a) **FUNDING REDUCTION.**—Notwithstanding the
3 amounts set forth in the funding tables in division D—

4 (1) The amount authorized to be appropriated
5 in section 101 for Aircraft Procurement, Navy, as
6 specified in the corresponding funding table in sec-
7 tion 4101, for MQ-8 UAV, Line 021, is hereby re-
8 duced by \$21,000,000 from the funds made avail-
9 able for costs associated with restoring 5 LCS.

10 (2) The amount authorized to be appropriated
11 in section 101 for Aircraft Procurement, Navy, as
12 specified in the corresponding funding table in sec-
13 tion 4101, for MQ-8 Series, Line 057, is hereby re-
14 duced by \$7,300,000 from the funds made available
15 for costs associated with restoring 5 LCS.

1 (3) The amount authorized to be appropriated
2 in section 101 for Aircraft Procurement, Navy, as
3 specified in the corresponding funding table in sec-
4 tion 4101, for Spares and Repair Parts, Line 068,
5 is hereby reduced by \$1,200,000 from the funds
6 made available for costs associated with restoring 5
7 LCS.

8 (4) The amount authorized to be appropriated
9 in section 421 for Military Personnel, as specified in
10 the corresponding funding table in section 4401, , is
11 hereby reduced by \$89,600,000 from the funds made
12 available for Military Personnel, Navy – Restore
13 Navy Force Structure Cuts (Manpower).

14 (5) The amount authorized to be appropriated
15 in section 301 for Operations and Maintenance,
16 Navy, as specified in the corresponding funding
17 table in section 4301, for Mission and Other Flight
18 Operations, Line 010, is hereby reduced by
19 \$6,000,000 from the funds made available for costs
20 associated with restoring 5 LCS.

21 (6) The amount authorized to be appropriated
22 in section 301 for Operations and Maintenance,
23 Navy, as specified in the corresponding funding
24 table in section 4301, for Aircraft Depot Mainte-
25 nance, Line 060, is hereby reduced by \$300,000

1 from the funds made available for costs associated
2 with restoring 5 LCS.

3 (7) The amount authorized to be appropriated
4 in section 301 for Operations and Maintenance,
5 Navy, as specified in the corresponding funding
6 table in section 4301, for Mission and Other Ship
7 Operations, Line 090, is hereby reduced by
8 \$10,400,000 from the funds made available for costs
9 associated with restoring 5 LCS.

10 (8) The amount authorized to be appropriated
11 in section 301 for Operations and Maintenance,
12 Navy, as specified in the corresponding funding
13 table in section 4301, for Ship Depot Maintenance,
14 Line 110, is hereby reduced by \$90,000,000 from
15 the funds made available for costs associated with
16 restoring 5 LCS.

17 (9) The amount authorized to be appropriated
18 in section 301 for Operations and Maintenance,
19 Navy, as specified in the corresponding funding
20 table in section 4301, for Weapons Maintenance,
21 Line 250, is hereby reduced by \$7,200,000 from the
22 funds made available for costs associated with re-
23 storing 5 LCS.

24 (10) The amount authorized to be appropriated
25 in section 301 for Operations and Maintenance,

1 Navy, as specified in the corresponding funding
2 table in section 4301, for Ship Activations/Inactiva-
3 tions, Line 320, is hereby reduced by \$7,500,000
4 from the funds made available for costs associated
5 with restoring 5 LCS.

6 (11) The amount authorized to be appropriated
7 in section 101 for Other Procurement, Navy, as
8 specified in the corresponding funding table in sec-
9 tion 4101, for LCS In-Service Modernization, Line
10 035, is hereby reduced by \$65,000,000 from the
11 funds made available for costs associated with re-
12 storing 5 LCS.

13 (12) The amount authorized to be appropriated
14 in section 201 for Research, Development, Test &
15 Eval, Navy, as specified in the corresponding fund-
16 ing table in section 4201, for MQ-8 UAV, Line 243,
17 is hereby reduced by \$13,100,000 from the funds
18 made available for costs associated with restoring 5
19 LCS.

20 (b) FUNDING INCREASE.—Notwithstanding the
21 amounts set forth in the funding tables in division D—

22 (1) The amount authorized to be appropriated
23 in section 101 for Procurement of Ammunition,
24 Army, as specified in the corresponding funding
25 table in section 4101, for Industrial Facilities, Line

1 034, is hereby increased by \$180,720,000 for Or-
2 ganic Ammunition Industrial Base Safety and Mod-
3 ernization Upgrades.

4 (2) The amount authorized to be appropriated
5 in section 301 for Operations and Maintenance,
6 Navy, as specified in the corresponding funding
7 table in section 4301, for Aviation Logistics, Line
8 080, is hereby increased by \$75,000,000.

9 (3) The amount authorized to be appropriated
10 in section 301 for Operations and Maintenance,
11 Navy, as specified in the corresponding funding
12 table in section 4301, for Combat Support Forces,
13 Line 170, is hereby increased by \$62,880,000.
