

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-

OFFERED BY MR. SORENSEN OF ILLINOIS

Add at the end of subtitle D of title XII the following:

1 **SEC. 12414. ETHANOL WAIVERS; REID VAPOR PRESSURE**
2 **LIMITATION.**

3 (a) EXISTING ETHANOL WAIVERS.—Section
4 211(f)(4) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7545(f)(4)) is
5 amended—

6 (1) by striking “(4) The Administrator, upon”
7 and inserting the following:

8 “(4) WAIVERS.—

9 “(A) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator,
10 on”;

11 (2) in subparagraph (A) (as so designated)—

12 (A) in the first sentence—

13 (i) by striking “of this subsection”
14 each place it appears; and

15 (ii) by striking “if he determines” and
16 inserting “if the Administrator deter-
17 mines”; and

1 (B) in the second sentence, by striking
2 “The Administrator” and inserting the fol-
3 lowing:

4 “(B) FINAL ACTION.—The Adminis-
5 trator”; and

6 (3) by adding at the end the following:

7 (b) REID VAPOR PRESSURE LIMITATION.—Section
8 211(h) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7545(h)) is
9 amended—

10 (1) by striking “vapor pressure” each place it
11 appears and inserting “Vapor Pressure”;

12 (2) in paragraph (4), in the matter preceding
13 subparagraph (A), by striking “10 percent” and in-
14 serting “10 to 15 percent”; and

15 (3) in paragraph (5)(A)—

16 (A) by striking “Upon notification, accom-
17 panied by” and inserting “On receipt of a noti-
18 fication that is submitted after the date of en-
19 actment of the Farm, Food, and National Secu-
20 rity Act of 2026, and is accompanied by appro-
21 priate”;

22 (B) by striking “10 percent” and inserting
23 “10 to 15 percent”; and

24 (C) by adding at the end the following:

25 “Upon the date of enactment of the Farm,

1 Food, and National Security Act of 2026, any
2 State for which the notification from the Gov-
3 ernor of a State was submitted before the date
4 of enactment of the Farm, Food, and National
5 Security Act of 2026 and to which the Adminis-
6 trator applied the Reid Vapor Pressure limita-
7 tion established by paragraph (1) shall instead
8 have the Reid Vapor Pressure limitation estab-
9 lished by paragraph (4) apply to all fuel blends
10 containing gasoline and 10 to 15 percent dena-
11 tured anhydrous ethanol that are sold, offered
12 for sale, dispensed, supplied, offered for supply,
13 transported, or introduced into commerce in the
14 area during the high ozone season.”.

15 “(C) REID VAPOR PRESSURE.—A fuel or
16 fuel additive may be introduced into commerce
17 if—

18 “(i)(I) the Administrator determines
19 that the fuel or fuel additive is substan-
20 tially similar to a fuel or fuel additive uti-
21 lized in the certification of any model year
22 vehicle pursuant to paragraph (1)(A); or

23 “(II) the fuel or fuel additive has been
24 granted a waiver under subparagraph (A)
25 and meets all of the conditions of that

1 waiver other than any limitation of the
2 waiver with respect to the Reid Vapor
3 Pressure of the fuel or fuel additive; and
4 “(ii) the fuel or fuel additive meets all
5 other applicable Reid Vapor Pressure re-
6 quirements under subsection (h).”.
