4	It is the sense of Congress that—
5	(1) the Secretary of Defense should consider
6	using emerging technologies, including quantum
7	computing, to address exposure to per- and
8	polyfluoroalkyl substances (in this section referred to
9	as "PFAS"); and
10	(2) in considering such technologies, the Sec-
11	retary should consider—
12	(A) the potential of the use of the unique
13	attributes of hybrid quantum classical com-
14	puting to address issues of chemical contamina-
15	tion, including exposure to PFAS;
16	(B) the potential of quantum computing to
17	address problems of exposure and potential re-

1	mediation solutions, and to develop alternatives
2	to materials containing PFAS;
3	(C) the existing and potential partnership
4	opportunities with academic institutions, private
5	sector technology and chemical companies, and
6	other Federal and State government entities;
7	(D) the availability of current and near-
8	term quantum computing resources, such as
9	cloud based quantum systems, as well as a
10	roadmap for long-term quantum development;
11	(E) the Department's current quantum
12	computing efforts, or other emerging tech-
13	nologies as the Secretary finds relevant; and
14	(F) the amount of funding that would be
15	required to take initial steps to leverage near-
16	term quantum computing, or other emerging

17 technologies as the Secretary finds relevant, to18 address the PFAS problem.
