

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1

OFFERED BY MS. SPEIER OF CALIFORNIA

Page 50, line 14, strike “and” at then end.

Page 50, line 20, insert “and” at the end.

Page 50, after line 20, insert the following:

1 (G) an explanation of what information the
2 State and local election officials maintain with
3 respect to an individual voter registration status
4 for purposes of elections for Federal office in
5 the State, how that information is shared or
6 sold and with whom, what information is auto-
7 matically kept confidential, what information is
8 needed to access voter information online, and
9 what privacy programs are available, such as
10 those described in section 1055;

Page 88, after line 8 insert the following (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

11 **SEC. 1055. REQUIRING STATES TO ESTABLISH AND OPER-**
12 **ATE VOTER PRIVACY PROGRAMS.**

13 (a) IN GENERAL.—Each State shall establish and op-
14 erate a privacy program to enable victims of domestic vio-

1 lence, dating violence, stalking, sexual assault, and traf-
2 ficking to have personally identifiable information that the
3 State or local election officials maintain with respect to
4 an individual voter registration status for purposes of elec-
5 tions for Federal office in the State, including addresses,
6 be kept confidential.

7 (b) NOTICE.—Each State shall notify residents of
8 that State of the information that State and local election
9 officials maintain with respect to an individual voter reg-
10 istration status for purposes of elections for Federal office
11 in the State, how that information is shared or sold and
12 with whom, what information is automatically kept con-
13 fidential, what information is needed to access voter infor-
14 mation online, and the privacy programs that are avail-
15 able.

16 (c) PUBLIC AVAILABILITY.—Each State shall make
17 information about the program established under sub-
18 section (a) available on a publicly accessible website.

19 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

20 (1) The terms “domestic violence”, “stalking”,
21 “sexual assault”, and “dating violence” have the
22 meanings given such terms in section 40002 of the
23 Violence Against Women Act of 1994 (34 U.S.C.
24 12291).

1 (2) The term “trafficking” means an act or
2 practice described in paragraph (11) or (12) of sec-
3 tion 103 of the Trafficking Victims Protection Act
4 of 2000 (22 U.S.C. 7102).
