Page 231, insert after line 17 the following (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

1 SEC. 1411. SURVIVORS' BILL OF RIGHTS.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Attorney General shall make
3 grants to States that have in place a law that provides
4 to sexual assault survivors the rights, at a minimum,
5 under section 3772 of title 18, United States Code.

6 (b) GRANT AMOUNT.—Subject to the availability of
7 appropriations, a grant to a State under this section shall
8 be equal to 10 percent of the average of the amount of
9 funding of the 3 most recent awards that the State re-
10 ceived under part T of title I of the Omnibus Crime Con-
11 trol and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. 10441 et
12 seq.) (commonly referred to as the “STOP Violence
13 Against Women Formula Grant Program”).

14 (c) APPLICATION.—A State seeking a grant under
15 this section shall submit an application to the Attorney
16 General at such time, in such manner, and containing
17 such information as the Attorney General may reasonably

- 2 subsection (a).
