11 "(a) CLAIMS AUTHORIZED.—Notwithstanding sec-12 tion 2680 of this title, a claim may be brought by a mem-13 ber of the Armed Forces (including a former member of 14 the Armed Forces if the claim arose while a member) 15 against the United States under this chapter for damages 16 or other appropriate relief for any act or omission related 17 to or arising out of covered assaultive conduct or the fail $\mathbf{2}$

ure to prevent or properly investigate or prosecute covered
 assaultive conduct.

3 "(b) COVERED ASSAULTIVE CONDUCT DEFINED.—
4 In this section, the term 'covered assaultive conduct'
5 means sexual assault or harassment, domestic violence, as6 sault and battery, intentional infliction of emotional dis7 tress, false imprisonment, or discrimination or negligent
8 hiring, supervision, promotion, or retention.

9 "(c) TREATMENT OF OVERSEAS ACTS OR OMIS-10 SIONS.—For purposes of a claim brought under this sec-11 tion, in the case of an act or omission described in sub-12 section (a) occurring outside the United States—

13 "(1) the law that applies to the act or omission 14 shall be the law of the place where the claimant is 15 domiciled within the United States, or, if there is no 16 place where the claimant is so domiciled, the law of 17 the place the claimant has identified as the claim-18 ant's home of record for military purposes; and

19 "(2) any choice-of-law rules which would re20 quire the application of foreign or international law
21 shall be disregarded.".
