RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-10
OFFERED BY MS. SPEIER OF CALIFORNIA

Page 18, after line 9, insert the following:

1 “(I) TESTING REQUIREMENTS.—

2 “ (i) IN GENERAL.—Any national pri-
3 mary drinking water regulation promul-
4 gated under subparagraph (A) or subpara-
5 graph (G)(ii) shall require public water
6 systems to conduct routine tests for the
7 presence of the perfluoroalkyl or
8 polyfluoroalkyl substance or class of
9 perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl substances
10 subject to such national primary drinking
11 water regulation in the drinking water of
12 each school and child care facility to which
13 such public water system provides drinking
14 water.

15 “(ii) INITIAL TESTING.—The Admin-
16 istrator shall ensure that each school and
17 child care facility to which a public water
18 system provides drinking water is tested
19 for the presence of any perfluoroalkyl or

1 polyfluoroalkyl substance or class of
2 perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl substances
3 subject to such national primary drinking
4 water regulation by not later than 1 year
5 after the date on which such regulation is
6 promulgated.

7 “(iii) STANDARDS.—The Adminis-
8 trator shall establish standards for the
9 testing required under clause (i), which
10 shall include identifying one or more ac-
11 ceptable testing methods for detecting the
12 presence of such substances.

13 “(iv) NOTICE OF RESULTS.—Each
14 public water system required to conduct
15 testing under clause (i) shall notify the ap-
16 plicable school or child care facility, and
17 the applicable State and local health de-
18 partment, of the results of each such test
19 not later than 1 week after such public
20 water system receives such results.

21 “(v) PUBLICATION OF RESULTS.—
22 Each public water system required to con-
23 duct testing under clause (i) shall publish
24 the results of each such test on a publicly
25 accessible website not later than 10 days

1 after the public water system receives such
2 results.”.
