

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 117-54
OFFERED BY MS. SPEIER OF CALIFORNIA

At the appropriate place in title LVIII, insert the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . REPORT ON WAIVERS UNDER SECTION 907 OF**
2 **THE FREEDOM FOR RUSSIA AND EMERGING**
3 **EURASIAN DEMOCRACIES AND OPEN MAR-**
4 **KETS SUPPORT ACT OF 1992.**

5 (a) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than 180 days
6 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
7 of State, in coordination with the Secretary of Defense,
8 shall submit a report to the appropriate congressional
9 committees on United States security assistance provided
10 to the Government of Azerbaijan pursuant to a waiver
11 under section 907 of the FREEDOM Support Act (22
12 U.S.C. 5812 note).

13 (b) ELEMENTS.—The report under subsection (a)
14 shall address the following:

15 (1) Documentation of the Department of
16 State's consideration of all section 907 waiver re-
17 quirements during the 5-year period ending on the
18 date of the enactment of this Act.

1 (2) Further program-level detail and end-use
2 monitoring reports of security assistance provided to
3 the Government of Azerbaijan under a section 907
4 waiver during such 5-year period.

5 (3) The impact of United States security assist-
6 ance provided to Azerbaijan on the negotiation of a
7 peaceful settlement between Armenia and Azerbaijan
8 over all disputed regions during such 5-year period.

9 (4) The impact of United States security assist-
10 ance provided to Azerbaijan on the military balance
11 between Azerbaijan and Armenia during such 5-year
12 period.

13 (5) An assessment of Azerbaijan’s use of offen-
14 sive force against Armenia or violations of Armenian
15 sovereign territory from November 11, 2020, to the
16 date of the enactment of this Act.

17 (c) BRIEFING.—The Secretary of State, in coordina-
18 tion with the Secretary of Defense, shall brief the appro-
19 priate congressional committees not later than 180 days
20 after the date of the enactment of this Act on the contents
21 of the report required under subsection (a).

22 (d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES.—
23 In this section, the term “appropriate congressional com-
24 mittees” means—

1 (1) the Committee on Armed Services and the
2 Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-
3 resentatives; and

4 (2) the Committee on Armed Services and the
5 Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate.
