

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 117-54**  
**OFFERED BY MS. SPEIER OF CALIFORNIA**

At the appropriate place in title LVIII, insert the following:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . GENDER ANALYSIS IN FOREIGN TRAINING PRO-**  
2 **GRAMS.**

3 (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con-  
4 gress that the President should encourage the increased  
5 participation of women in existing programs funded by the  
6 United States Government that provide training to foreign  
7 nationals regarding law enforcement, the rule of law, or  
8 professional military education, and should expand and  
9 apply gender analysis to improve program design and im-  
10 plementation.

11 (b) GENDER ANALYSIS OF INTERNATIONAL TRAIN-  
12 ING PROGRAMS.—The Department of Defense, in coordi-  
13 nation with the Department of State and other relevant  
14 departments, shall conduct a gender analysis of Inter-  
15 national Education and Training Programs offered to al-  
16 lied and partner forces to ensure the programs are equi-  
17 table and address issues experienced by all participants.

18 (c) GENDER ANALYSIS TRAINING.—The Department  
19 of Defense, in coordination with the Department of State,

1 shall develop and include gender analysis training to be  
2 included in the International Education and Training Pro-  
3 grams at United States military schools and training insti-  
4 tutions.

5 (d) BRIEFING REQUIRED.—No later than two years  
6 after enactment of this act, the Secretary of Defense, in  
7 coordination with the Secretary of State, shall brief the  
8 appropriate congressional committees on the Department  
9 of Defense and Department of State’s actions and  
10 progress in implementing the requirements under sub-  
11 section (b) and subsection (c).

12 (e) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-  
13 FINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate congres-  
14 sional committees” means—

15 (1) the Committee on Armed Services and the  
16 Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-  
17 resentatives; and

18 (2) the Committee on Armed Services and the  
19 Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate.

20 (f) GENDER ANALYSIS DEFINED.—In this section,  
21 the term “gender analysis” has the meaning given such  
22 term in section 3 of the Women’s Entrepreneurship and  
23 Economic Empowerment Act (22 U.S.C. 2151–2).
