At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, add the following new section:

1	SEC. 17 ANNUAL SUBMISSION OF INFORMATION BY
2	THE SECRETARY OF VETERANS AFFAIRS ON
3	RECOGNITION OF AGENTS, ATTORNEYS, OR-
4	GANIZATIONS AND THEIR REPRESENTATIVES
5	AND OTHER INDIVIDUALS FOR THE PUR-
6	POSES OF ASSISTING IN THE PREPARATION,
7	PRESENTATION, AND PROSECUTION OF
8	CLAIMS FOR BENEFITS.
9	(a) Annual Report.—Chapter 59 of title 38,
10	United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the
11	following new sections:
12	"§ 5907. Annual submission of information on rec-
13	ognition of agents, attorneys, organiza-
14	tions and their representatives, and other
15	individuals
16	"The Secretary shall include in the annual report re-
17	quired to be submitted to Congress under section 529 of
18	this title information on agents, attorneys, organizations

1	and their representatives, and any other individuals recog-
2	nized under this chapter. Such information shall include,
3	for the year covered by the report, the following:
4	"(1) A description of the type and frequency of
5	training that is required to be recognized, or to con-
6	tinue to be recognized, under this chapter and of
7	any review or audit conducted of such training.
8	"(2) A description of the type of information
9	the Secretary collects from individuals who request
10	to be recognized, or to continue to be recognized,
11	under this chapter.
12	"(3) A description of the method the Secretary
13	uses to gather personal and qualifying information
14	from individuals and organizations recognized or
15	seeking recognition under this chapter.
16	"(4) An identification of the frequency with
17	which the Secretary receives updated personal and
18	qualifying information from individuals and organi-
19	zations recognized under this chapter.
20	"(5) A description of the method the Secretary
21	uses to verify personal and qualifying information
22	received from individuals and organizations recog-
23	nized or seeking recognition under this chapter.
24	"(6) An identification of the frequency with
25	which individuals and organizations recognized

1	under this chapter are required to comply with ongo-
2	ing reporting requirements.
3	"(7) An identification of the number of Depart-
4	ment employees responsible for the administration of
5	this chapter.
6	"(8) An identification of the frequency with
7	which the VA Accreditation Search Database, or any
8	successor to such database, is—
9	"(A) updated; and
10	"(B) checked for accuracy, including with
11	respect to the accuracy of contact information
12	and the removal of individuals and organiza-
13	tions no longer needed to assist veterans in the
14	preparation, presentation, or prosecution of the
15	laws administered by the Secretary.
16	"(9) A description of the steps the Secretary
17	has taken to ensure such database is updated.
18	"(10) An identification of any additional re-
19	sources the Department may need to ensure that—
20	"(A) any published information regarding
21	individuals and organizations recognized under
22	this chapter is accurate and up-to-date; and
23	"(B) individuals who are recognized under
24	this chapter are of good moral character and in
25	good repute, are qualified to render claimants

1	valuable service, and are otherwise competent to
2	assist claimants in presenting claims under laws
3	administered by the Secretary.
4	"(11) An identification of the costs of proc-
5	essing applications for recognition under this chap-
6	ter.
7	"(12) A description of the timeline for proc-
8	essing applications under this chapter.
9	"(13) An identification of how frequently indi-
10	viduals seeking recognition under this chapter are
11	denied such recognition and for what reasons.
12	"(14) An identification of how frequently rec-
13	ognition is rescinded from individuals recognized
14	under this chapter and for what reasons.
15	"§ 5908. Certification mark for identification of recog-
16	nized individuals
17	"(a) In General.—The Secretary shall establish
18	and maintain a certification mark, which may be used to
19	identify individuals who are recognized under this chapter
20	for the purposes of assisting in the preparation, presen-
21	tation, and prosecution of claims for benefits under the
22	laws administered by the Secretary. Such certification
23	mark shall be registered with the United States Patent
24	and Trademark Office.

- 1 "(b) CIVIL PENALTY FOR VIOLATION.—(1) A person
- 2 who displays or otherwise uses the certification mark es-
- 3 tablished under subsection (a) for the fraudulent purposes
- 4 of inducing the belief that the person is recognized under
- 5 this chapter for the purposes of assisting the preparation,
- 6 presentation, and prosecution of claims for benefits under
- 7 the laws administered by the Secretary shall be fined in
- 8 accordance with title 18, imprisoned, or both.
- 9 "(2) This subsection shall not make unlawful the use
- 10 of any such emblem, sign, insignia, or words which was
- 11 lawful on the date of enactment of this section.
- 12 "(3) Amounts collected as civil penalties pursuant to
- 13 this subsection shall remain available for the Department,
- 14 without fiscal year limitation, for the purpose of enforcing
- 15 paragraph (1).".
- 16 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
- 17 at the beginning of such chapter is amended by inserting
- 18 after the item relating to section 5906 the following new
- 19 items:
 - "5907. Annual submission of information on recognition of agents, attorneys, organizations and their representatives, and other individuals "5908. Certification mark for identification of recognized individuals".
- 20 (c) Biannual Database Accuracy.—Not later
- 21 than 180 days after the date on which the Secretary sub-
- 22 mits the first report under 529 of title 38, United States
- 23 Code, that includes the information required to be sub-
- 24 mitted under section 5907 of such title, as added by this

1	section, and annually thereafter, the Secretary of Veterans
2	Affairs shall—
3	(1) provide to each individual recognized under
4	chapter 59 of such title a notice that includes a re-
5	quest to update the contact information provided to
6	the Department of Veterans Affairs;
7	(2) make publically available instructions such
8	individuals may use to update such contact informa-
9	tion; and
10	(3) ensure the VA Accreditation Search Data-
11	base is updated to include such updated contact in-
12	formation.
13	(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
14	authorized to be appropriated for fiscal year 2026 and
15	each of the next four fiscal years for the Department of
16	Veterans Affairs such sums as may be necessary to—
17	(1) carry out this section and the amendments
18	made by this section; and
19	(2) employ four additional full-time employees
20	of the Department to perform functions to carry out
21	this section and the amendments made by this sec-
22	tion.
