Amendment to H.R. 8038 Offered by Mr. Stanton of Arizona

At the appropriate place, add the following:

1 SEC. _. SUBNATIONAL COOPERATION STRATEGY.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 270 days after the 3 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State, in coordination with the Administrator of the United 4 5 States Agency for International Development, shall submit 6 to the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-7 resentatives and the Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate a strategy on efforts to strengthen subnational 8 9 cooperation between the United States and Mexico for the purposes of— 10

- (1) enhancing law enforcement cooperation and
 local, State, and Federal security forces cooperation
 at a subnational level for the purpose of curbing
 fentanyl trafficking and other synthetic opioids, including activities such as—
- 16 (A) bolstering technical assistance and co17 ordination for law enforcement agencies and
 18 local, State, and Federal security forces;
- (B) carrying out exchange programs forthe purposes of professional development; and

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1 (C) enhancing data sharing, as appro-2 priate; and

3 (2) bolstering subnational dialogue and capacity
4 building between Federal and local governments,
5 civil society, faith-based organizations, and business
6 community leaders and integrating issues faced by
7 local communities, including with respect to traf8 ficking of fentanyl and other synthetic opioids.

9 (b) UPDATE.—Not later than 2 years after the date 10 of the submission of the strategy under subsection (a), the 11 President shall submit to the congressional committees 12 specified in subsection (a) an update containing an assess-13 ment of the implementation and effectiveness of the strat-14 egy, lessons learned from the past year with respect to 15 the strategy, and planned changes to the strategy.

16 (c) FORM.—The strategy under subsection (a), and
17 the update under subsection (b), shall be submitted in un18 classified form.

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
