

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 7006**OFFERED BY MS. STANSBURY OF NEW MEXICO**

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 **DIVISION D—LIMITATION ON**
2 **IMPOUNDMENT; DOGE AUDIT**

3 **SEC. ____ . LIMITATION ON IMPOUNDMENT OF FUNDS; DOGE**
4 **AUDIT.**

5 (a) **LIMITATION.**—None of the funds made available
6 by any division of this Act may be used by the Office of
7 Management and Budget, or by any department or agency
8 acting at the direction of the Office of Management and
9 Budget, to withhold, delay, defer, or otherwise impede the
10 obligation or expenditure of funds in a manner incon-
11 sistent with the Impoundment Control Act of 1974 (2
12 U.S.C. 681 et seq.). For purposes of this section, the with-
13 holding of funds for the purpose of avoiding obligation
14 prior to the expiration of budget authority, without the
15 transmission of a special message pursuant to the Im-
16 poundment Control Act of 1974, shall be deemed an im-
17 permissible impoundment.

18 (b) **AUDIT.**—Not later than 30 days after the date
19 of the enactment of this Act, the Office of Management
20 and Budget shall provide a full audit to the Committee

1 of Oversight and Government Reform of the House of
2 Representatives on the following:

3 (1) All federal funding spent to implement any
4 action under the DOGE initiative, including costs
5 associated with closing or changing Federal agencies
6 and offices, changes in employment status of Fed-
7 eral employees, contracts, litigation, and other costs,
8 enumerated by cost, action, agency, and date.

9 (2) All Federal funding saved through the im-
10 plementation of DOGE activities, enumerated by
11 specific savings, action, agency, and date.

12 (3) The number, classification, programs, agen-
13 cies and authorities of all Federal employees who
14 left Federal service as a result of DOGE activities.

15 (4) The names of all agencies, departments,
16 and programs closed or reconfigured pursuant to to
17 DOGE activities, a description and justification for
18 each action, and the legal authorities under which
19 they closures and changes were made.

20 (5) A full accounting and detailed list of Fed-
21 eral data sets accessed and potentially downloaded
22 as part of DOGE activities including the agency,
23 program, data, dates, descriptions, and purpose for
24 such actions.

1 (6) Any new or revised contracts for Federal
2 funds resulting from DOGE activities, including by
3 agency, program, dollar amount, contractee, and
4 purpose.

5 (7) A list of all litigation filed in response to
6 DOGE activities in which the Federal Government is
7 a party, including a list of cases by name,
8 jurisdiction, parties involved, and a description.
