OFFERED BY MRS. STEEL OF CALIFORNIA

Add at the end of subtitle E of title VIII the following new section:

1 SEC. 859. PROHIBITION ON THE USE OF LOGINK.

2 (a) PROHIBITION.—

3 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense,
4 each Secretary of a military department, and a de-
5 fense contractor may not use LOGINK.

6 (2) APPLICABILITY.—With respect to defense
7 contractors, the prohibition in subsection (a) shall
8 apply—

9 (A) with respect to any contract of the De-
10 partment of Defense entered into on or after
11 the date of the enactment of this section;

12 (B) with respect to the use of LOGINK in
13 the performance of such contract.

14 (b) CONTRACTING PROHIBITION.—

15 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense
16 and each Secretary of a military department may
17 not enter into any contract with an entity that uses
18 LOGINK and shall prohibit the use of LOGINK in

1 any contract entered into by the Department of De-
2 fense.

3 (2) DEFENSE CONTRACTOR.—With respect to
4 any contract of the Department of Defense, a de-
5 fense contractor may not enter into a subcontract
6 with an entity that uses LOGINK.

7 (3) APPLICABILITY.—This subsection applies
8 with respect to any contract entered into on or after
9 the date of the enactment of this section.

10 (c) LOGINK DEFINED.—In this section, the term
11 “LOGINK” means the public, open, shared logistics infor-
12 mation network known as the National Public Information
13 Platform for Transportation & Logistics by the Ministry
14 of Transport of China.
