

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 8036**  
**OFFERED BY MRS. STEEL OF CALIFORNIA**

At the end of the bill (before the short title), add the following:

1           **TITLE \_\_—SOLIDIFY IRAN**  
2           **SANCTIONS ACT OF 2024**

3 **SEC. \_\_1. SHORT TITLE.**

4           This Act may be cited as the “Solidify Iran Sanctions  
5 Act of 2024”.

6 **SEC. \_\_2. FINDINGS.**

7           Congress makes the following findings:

8           (1) The Iran Sanctions Act of 1996 (Public  
9 Law 104–172; 50 U.S.C. 1701 note) requires the  
10 imposition of sanctions with respect to Iran’s illicit  
11 weapons programs, conventional weapons and bal-  
12 listic missile development, and support for terrorism,  
13 including Iran’s Revolutionary Guards Corps.

14           (2) The Government of Iran has acquired de-  
15 stabilizing conventional weapons systems from the  
16 Russian Federation and other malign actors, and is  
17 funneling weapons and financial support to its ter-  
18 rorist proxies throughout the Middle East, threat-

1 ening allies and partners of the United States, such  
2 as Israel.

3 **SEC. 3. STATEMENT OF POLICY.**

4 It is the policy of the United States to fully imple-  
5 ment and enforce the Iran Sanctions Act of 1996 (Public  
6 Law 104–172; 50 U.S.C. 1701 note).

7 **SEC. 4. REPEAL OF SUNSET.**

8 Section 13 of the Iran Sanctions Act of 1996 (Public  
9 Law 104–172; 50 U.S.C. 1701 note) is amended—

10 (1) in the section heading, by striking “; **SUN-**  
11 **SET**”;

12 (2) by striking “(a) EFFECTIVE DATE.—”; and

13 (3) by striking subsection (b).
