

**AMENDMENT TO**  
**RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-8**  
**OFFERED BY MS. STEFANIK OF NEW YORK**

At the end of subtitle A of title XVII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 17\_\_\_ . EVALUATION OF RISKS POSED BY COMMUNICA-**  
2 **TIONS EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES PRO-**  
3 **DUCED BY FOREIGN ADVERSARY ENTITIES.**

4 Section 1709 of the National Defense Authorization  
5 Act for Fiscal Year 2025 (Public Law 118-159; 47 U.S.C.  
6 1601 note) is amended—

7 (1) in subsection (a), in the subsection heading,  
8 by striking “TO COVERED LIST” and inserting  
9 “PRODUCED BY DJI TECHNOLOGIES OR AUTEL RO-  
10 BOTICS”;

11 (2) by redesignating subsections (b), (c), and  
12 (d) as subsections (c), (d), and (e), respectively;

13 (3) by inserting after subsection (a) the fol-  
14 lowing new subsection:

15 “(b) EVALUATION OF UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYS-  
16 TEMS COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES PRO-  
17 DUCED BY FOREIGN ADVERSARY ENTITIES.—

1           “(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than one year  
2 after the date of the enactment of the National De-  
3 fense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2026, an ap-  
4 propriate national security agency shall determine if  
5 any of the following communications equipment or  
6 services, including software, pose an unacceptable  
7 risk to the national security of the United States or  
8 the security and safety of United States persons:

9           “(A) Unmanned aircraft systems or cam-  
10 eras that are designed, developed, manufac-  
11 tured, or supplied by any person owned by, con-  
12 trolled by, or subject to the jurisdiction or di-  
13 rection of a foreign adversary.

14           “(B) Unmanned aircraft systems or cam-  
15 eras with integrated software provided by any  
16 person owned by, controlled by, or subject to  
17 the jurisdiction or direction of a foreign adver-  
18 sary.

19           “(C) Equipment that uses spectrum in the  
20 5030–5091 MHz band, governed by part 88 of  
21 title 47, Code of Federal Regulations (or suc-  
22 cessor regulations), or in the 5150–5850 MHz  
23 band, governed by part 15 of title 47, Code of  
24 Federal Regulations (or successor regulations),  
25 that is designed, developed, manufactured, li-

1 censed, or supplied by any person owned by,  
2 controlled by, or subject to the jurisdiction or  
3 direction of a foreign adversary.

4 “(2) ADDITION TO THE COVERED LIST.—If the  
5 appropriate national security agency does not make  
6 a determination as required by paragraph (1) by the  
7 date that is one year after the date of the enactment  
8 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal  
9 Year 2026, the Commission shall add all equipment  
10 and services listed in paragraph (1) to the covered  
11 list.”;

12 (4) in subsection (c), as redesignated by para-  
13 graph (2), by inserting “or (b)(1)” after “subsection  
14 (a)(1)” each place it appears;

15 (5) in subsection (d), as so redesignated, by  
16 adding at the end the following:

17 “(6) The term ‘unmanned aircraft system’ has  
18 the meaning given that term in section 44801 of  
19 title 49, United States Code.

20 “(7) The term ‘foreign adversary’—

21 “(A) means a foreign adversary (as such  
22 term is defined in section 8(c) of the Secure  
23 and Trusted Communications Networks Act of  
24 2019 (47 U.S.C. 1607(c)); and

1           “(B) includes any person owned by, con-  
2           trolled by, or subject to the jurisdiction or di-  
3           rection of a foreign adversary.

4           “(8) The term ‘person owned by, controlled by,  
5           or subject to the jurisdiction or direction of a foreign  
6           adversary’ has the meaning given such term in sec-  
7           tion 791.301 of title 15, Code of Federal Regula-  
8           tions, or any such successor regulation.”; and  
9           (6) in subsection (e), as so redesignated, by  
10          striking “subsection (b)(1)(A)” and inserting “sub-  
11          section (c)(1)(A)”.
