

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 116-57
OFFERED BY MR. STEIL OF WISCONSIN

At the end of subtitle C of title XII, add the following:

1 **SEC. __ REPORT ON THE THREAT POSED BY IRANIAN-**
2 **BACKED MILITIAS IN IRAQ.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
4 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of De-
5 fense, in consultation with the Secretary of State, shall
6 submit to the appropriate congressional committees a re-
7 port on the short- and long-term threats posed by Iranian-
8 backed militias in Iraq to Iraq and to United States per-
9 sons and interests.

10 (b) ELEMENTS.—The report required by subsection
11 (a) shall include the following:

12 (1) A detailed description of acts of violence
13 and intimidation that Iranian-backed militias in Iraq
14 have committed against Iraqi civilians during the
15 previous two years.

16 (2) A detailed description of the threat that
17 Iranian-backed militias in Iraq pose to United States
18 persons in Iraq and in the Middle East, including
19 United States Armed Forces and diplomats.

1 (3) A detailed description of the threat Iranian-
2 backed militias in Iraq pose to United States part-
3 ners in the region.

4 (4) A detailed description of the role that Ira-
5 nian-backed militias in Iraq play in Iraq’s armed
6 forces and security services, including Iraq’s Popular
7 Mobilization Forces; .

8 (5) An assessment of whether and to what ex-
9 tent any Iranian-backed militia in Iraq, or member
10 of such militia, had illicit access to United States-
11 origin defense equipment provided to Iraq since
12 2014 and the response from the Government of Iraq
13 to each incident.

14 (c) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a)
15 shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include
16 a classified annex only if such annex is provided separately
17 from the unclassified report.

18 (d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES
19 DEFINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate con-
20 gressional committees” means—

21 (1) the Committee on Armed Services and the
22 Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-
23 resentatives; and

- 1 (2) the Committee on Armed Services and the
- 2 Committee Foreign Relations of the Senate.
