Page 79, after line 24, insert the following:

1 FOSTER CARE RESIDENTIAL INTEGRATIVE CAMPUS

2 TRAUMA GRANT

3 For a grant to support an innovative demonstration
4 project that shall provide evidence-based clinical services,
5 foster parent training and support services, positive bio-
6 logical family engagement, enrichment activities for chil-
7 dren, and trauma-informed systems work, comprised of an
8 integrative innovative campus with individually licensed
9 residential homes and outpatient behavioral health serv-
10 ices by a multi-disciplinary licensed clinical staff with at
11 least 1 individual who has a Doctorate of Psychology de-
12 gree and is an expert programming officer or administra-
13 tive leader and the organization using documented multi-
14 method analytic research methodologies with a focus on
15 reliability, validity and variation in reports providing accu-
16 rate representations of intersections among family and
17 caregiver relationships on child growth and development
18 services, research, increasing access, enrichment, and edu-
19 cational programming for foster youth, and to provide

1 support services to foster parents, and engage with the
2 biological families in a positive manner to promote perma-
3 nency, \$2,000,000: *Provided*, That the grant shall not be
4 used for development activities or building, facilities man-
5 agement, and renovation: *Provided further*, That the Sec-
6 retary of Health and Human Services shall award the
7 grant to an organization described in section 501(c)(3) of
8 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (other than an edu-
9 cational organization) that is exempt from taxation under
10 section 501(a) of such Code with demonstrated experience
11 in providing trauma-informed interventional programming
12 for children and families in foster care, that has an inte-
13 grative residential foster care campus utilizing at least 5
14 individually licensed foster care homes and outpatient be-
15 havioral health services by a multi-disciplinary licensed
16 clinical staff with at least 1 individual who has a Doc-
17 torate of Psychology degree and is an expert programming
18 officer or administrative leader and the organization using
19 documented multi-method analytic research methodologies
20 with a focus on reliability, validity and variation in reports
21 providing accurate representations of intersections among
22 family and caregiver relationships on child growth and de-
23 velopment: *Provided further*, That the Congress intends
24 that the grant not be awarded to an organization that
25 owns or operates a facility that provides 24-hour nonmed-

1 ical care and supervision to children or adults in a struc-
2 tured environment: *Provided further*, That the grantee
3 shall report regularly to the Secretary on findings, out-
4 comes, and recommendations regarding replicable pro-
5 grammatic models: *Provided further*, That the grantee
6 shall have program evaluation and institutional review
7 board-approved research supported by content area ex-
8 perts.
