4           (a) PREVENTING ALLOCATIONS OF SPECIAL DRAW-  
5     ING RIGHTS AT THE INTERNATIONAL MONETARY FUND  
6     FOR COUNTRIES THAT ARE PERPETRATORS OF GENO-  
7     CIDЕ OR STATE SPONSORS OF TERRORISM.—The Bretton  
8     Woods Agreements Act (22 U.S.C. 286 et seq.) is amend-  
9     ed by adding at the end the following:

10    **“SEC. 74. PREVENTING ALLOCATIONS OF SPECIAL DRAW-**  
11                                   **ING RIGHTS FOR COUNTRIES THAT ARE PER-**  
12                                   **PETRATORS OF GENOCIDE OR STATE SPON-**  
13                                   **SORS OF TERRORISM.**

14           “The Secretary of the Treasury shall instruct the  
15     United States Executive Director at the Fund to use the  
16     voice and vote of the United States to—

17                   “(1) oppose the allocation of Special Drawing  
18     Rights to any country that is a perpetrator of geno-

1       cide or a state sponsor of terrorism, as determined  
2       by the Secretary of State; and

3               “(2) advocate that the Fund adopt a rule pro-  
4       hibiting such an allocation.”.

5       (b) PREVENTING UNITED STATES TAX DOLLARS  
6 FROM BEING PROVIDED TO THE TALIBAN OR OTHER  
7 TERRORIST ORGANIZATIONS OR COUNTRIES THAT HAR-  
8 BOR TERRORIST ORGANIZATIONS.—

9               (1) REVIEW.—

10               (A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the  
11       Treasury, the Secretary of State, and the Ad-  
12       ministrator of the United States Agency for  
13       International Development shall jointly conduct  
14       a review of assistance provided to nongovern-  
15       mental organizations and international organi-  
16       zations to ensure such assistance is not being  
17       further provided to the Taliban or other ter-  
18       rorist organizations or countries that harbor  
19       terrorist organizations in accordance with  
20       United States anti-terrorism financing laws.

21               (B) REPORT.—Not later than 90 days  
22       after the date of the enactment of this Act, the  
23       Secretary of the Treasury, the Secretary of  
24       State, and the Administrator of the United  
25       States Agency for International Development

1           shall jointly submit to Congress a report that  
2           contains the results of the review conducted  
3           under subparagraph (A).

4           (2) RECIPIENT REQUIREMENTS.—Not later  
5           than 180 days after the date of the enactment of  
6           this Act, the Secretary of the Treasury, the Sec-  
7           retary of State, and the Administrator of the United  
8           States Agency for International Development shall  
9           each require prime awardees of assistance to provide  
10          evidence that all sub-awardees of such assistance are  
11          complying with United States anti-terrorism financ-  
12          ing laws.
