## Amendment to H.R. \_\_\_\_\_ Offered by Mr. Steube of Florida

Add at the end of the bill the following:

## 1 SEC. \_\_\_\_. DESIGNATION AS FTO; IMPOSITION OF SANC 2 TIONS.

3 (a) DESIGNATION AS FTO.—Not later than 90 days
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
5 of State shall designate as a foreign terrorist organization
6 pursuant to section 219(a) of the Immigration and Na7 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1189(a)) each of the following:

- 8 (1) Abu Fadl al-Abbas Brigades.
- 9 (2) Ansarallah (otherwise known as the10 "Houthis").
- 11 (3) Badr Organization.
- 12 (4) Fatemiyoun Brigade.
- 13 (5) Harakat Hezbollah al-Nujaba.
- 14 (6) Kata'ib al-Imam Ali.
- 15 (7) Kata'ib Jund al-Imam.
- 16 (8) Kata'ib Sayyad al Shuhada.
- 17 (9) Sarayya al-Jihad.
- 18 (10) Sarayya Khorasani.
- 19 (11) Zainabiyoun Brigade.

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1	(12) Any foreign entity or organization that is
2	an agent of, affiliated with, or owned or controlled
3	by the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps.
4	(b) Imposition of Sanctions.—
5	(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 60 days after
6	the date of the enactment of this Act, the President
7	shall determine whether to impose the sanctions de-
8	scribed in paragraph (3) on any organization listed
9	under paragraph $(2)$ or any entity or organization
10	that is an agent, affiliate, or instrumentality, or
11	owned or controlled by an agent, affiliate, or instru-
12	mentality of an organization listed in paragraph $(2)$ .
13	(2) Organizations.—The following are organi-
14	zations with respect to which a sanction determina-
15	tion shall be made:
16	(A) Abu Fadl al-Abbas Brigades.
17	(B) Badr Organization.
18	(C) Kata'ib al-Imam Ali.
19	(D) Kata'ib Jund al-Imam.
20	(E) Sarayya al-Jihad.
21	(F) Sarayya Khorasani.
22	(3) SANCTIONS DESCRIBED.—The sanctions de-
23	scribed in this subsection are sanctions applicable
24	with respect to a foreign person pursuant to Execu-
25	tive Order 13224 (50 U.S.C. 1701 note; relating to

blocking property and prohibiting transactions with
 persons who commit, threaten to commit, or support
 terrorism).

4 (c) REPORT.—

5 (1) SECRETARY OF STATE REPORT.—Not later 6 than 180 days after the date of enactment of this 7 Act, and every 180 days thereafter, the Secretary of 8 State, in consultation with the Secretary of Com-9 merce, shall submit to Congress a report on any new 10 entities meeting the requirements for—

11 (A) designation as a foreign terrorist orga-12 nization; or

(B) imposition of sanctions with respect to
a foreign person pursuant to Executive Order
13224 (50 U.S.C. 1701 note; relating to blocking property and prohibiting transactions with
persons who commit, threaten to commit, or
support terrorism).

(2) PRESIDENTIAL REPORT.—The President
shall submit to Congress a report not later than 60
days after a determination has been made under
subsection (b) on whether the organizations listed
under such subsection have sanctions imposed pursuant to Executive Order 13224 and shall provide a

- 2 not be sanctioned.

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
