

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 8646, AS REPORTED**  
**OFFERED BY MR. STEUBE OF FLORIDA**

At the end of the bill (before the short title), insert the following:

1       SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. (a) None of the funds made available by  
2 this Act may be used to administer, approve, guarantee,  
3 insure, issue, subsidize, or otherwise support any acquisi-  
4 tion, agreement, cooperative agreement, easement, grant,  
5 lease, loan, or loan guarantee of any interest in agricul-  
6 tural land by a covered foreign person.

7       (b) For purposes of this section:

8           (1) The term “agricultural land” has the mean-  
9 ing given the term in section 9 of the Agricultural  
10 Foreign Investment Disclosure Act of 1978 (7  
11 U.S.C. 3508).

12          (2) The term “covered foreign person” means  
13 any foreign person that is—

14           (A) the government of a foreign adversary;

15           (B) the government of a state sponsor of  
16 terrorism;

17           (C) a person organized under the laws of,  
18 headquartered in, or having its principal place

1 of business in a foreign adversary or state spon-  
2 sor of terrorism; or

3 (D) a person owned or controlled by, act-  
4 ing on behalf of, or affiliated with a foreign ad-  
5 versary or a state sponsor of terrorism.

6 (3) The term “foreign adversary” means any  
7 foreign government or foreign nongovernment person  
8 engaged in a long-term pattern or serious instances  
9 of conduct significantly adverse to the national secu-  
10 rity of the United States or the security and safety  
11 of United States persons.

12 (4) The term “state sponsor of terrorism”  
13 means a country the government of which the Sec-  
14 retary of State determines has repeatedly provided  
15 support for international terrorism pursuant to—

16 (A) section 1754(c)(1)(A) of the Export  
17 Control Reform Act of 2018 (50 U.S.C.  
18 4813(c)(1)(A));

19 (B) section 620A of the Foreign Assistance  
20 Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2371);

21 (C) section 40 of the Arms Export Control  
22 Act (22 U.S.C. 2780); or

23 (D) any other provision of law.

24 (5) The term “United States” means the sev-  
25 eral States, the District of Columbia, the Common-

1       wealth of Puerto Rico, the Commonwealth of the  
2       Northern Mariana Islands, American Samoa, Guam,  
3       the United States Virgin Islands, and any other ter-  
4       ritory or possession of the United States.
