

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-33
OFFERED BY MR. STEUBE OF FLORIDA

At the end of subtitle B of title XVI, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 16___ . SUBMISSION OF REPORTS ON OPEN-SOURCE**
2 **INTELLIGENCE PROGRAMS OF DEPARTMENT**
3 **OF DEFENSE.**

4 Title V of the National Security Act of 1947 (50
5 U.S.C. 3091 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end
6 the following new section (and by conforming the table of
7 contents at the beginning of such Act accordingly):

8 **“SEC. 519. SUBMISSION OF REPORTS ON OPEN-SOURCE IN-**
9 **TELLIGENCE PROGRAMS OF DEPARTMENT**
10 **OF DEFENSE.**

11 “(a) AVAILABILITY OF REPORTS.—

12 “(1) REQUIREMENT.—The Under Secretary of
13 Defense for Intelligence and Security shall submit to
14 the congressional intelligence committees each report
15 submitted to the Under Secretary pursuant to De-
16 partment of Defense Instruction 3115.12 (relating
17 to open-source intelligence), or any successor in-

1 struction, by not later than 14 days after the date
2 on which the Under Secretary receives such report.

3 “(2) INCLUSION OF CERTAIN MATTERS.—On an
4 annual basis, the Under Secretary of Defense for In-
5 telligence and Security shall include in a report
6 under paragraph (1), or shall submit to the congres-
7 sional intelligence committees a separate report con-
8 taining, the following:

9 “(A) An assessment of the open-source in-
10 telligence programs and activities of the De-
11 partment of Defense in satisfying the policy of
12 the Department and validated joint require-
13 ments, including performance metrics.

14 “(B) Identification of issues that hinder
15 the effectiveness and integration of such pro-
16 grams and activities.

17 “(C) Prioritized recommendations con-
18 cerning policy changes, resource adjustments,
19 or other initiatives needed to improve such pro-
20 grams and activities.

21 “(b) CERTIFICATION.—At the time that the Presi-
22 dent submits the budget for a fiscal year under section
23 1105 of title 31, United States Code, the Under Secretary
24 of Defense for Intelligence and Security shall—

1 “(1) certify to the congressional intelligence
2 committees that the open-source intelligence pro-
3 grams of the Department of Defense—

4 “(A) satisfy validated joint requirements;

5 “(B) are aligned with the policy of the De-
6 partment and the standards of the intelligence
7 community;

8 “(C) are effectively integrated across the
9 Defense Intelligence Enterprise (as defined in
10 section 426 of title 10, United States Code);
11 and

12 “(D) do not unnecessarily duplicate or
13 overlap with other capabilities of the Depart-
14 ment or intelligence community; or

15 “(2) if the Under Secretary is unable to make
16 such certification, submit to the congressional intel-
17 ligence committees a notification of—

18 “(A) the specific deficiencies that prevent
19 such certification;

20 “(B) the components of the Department
21 responsible for such deficiencies; and

22 “(C) planned corrective actions, including
23 timelines.

1 “(c) FORM.—Each report, certification, or notifica-
2 tion submitted under this section shall be submitted in un-
3 classified form, but may include a classified annex.”.
