

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119-33
OFFERED BY MR. STEUBE OF FLORIDA

In title XVI, subtitle B, add at the end the following
new section:

1 **SEC. 16 ____ . OPEN-SOURCE INTELLIGENCE INTEGRATION**
2 **INTO DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE COLLEC-**
3 **TION MANAGEMENT.**

4 (a) RECOGNITION AND INTEGRATION OF OPEN-
5 SOURCE INTELLIGENCE.—The Under Secretary of De-
6 fense for Intelligence and Security shall—

7 (1) ensure that the Department of Defense rec-
8 ognizes open-source intelligence as a source of intel-
9 ligence collection;

10 (2) integrate open-source intelligence into the
11 processes of the Department for intelligence collec-
12 tion management, including processes for require-
13 ments development, prioritization, and tasking;

14 (3) maintain procedures for identifying and
15 validating intelligence requirements that may be sat-
16 isfied through open-source intelligence;

17 (4) maintain guidance for tasking, coordination,
18 and deconfliction of open-source intelligence collec-
19 tion activities across the Department;

1 (5) identify roles and responsibilities for ele-
2 ments of the Department conducting open-source in-
3 telligence collection, including the Defense Intel-
4 ligence Agency, the military departments, and the
5 combatant commands; and

6 (6) maintain alignment of open-source intel-
7 ligence collection activities with policies of the De-
8 partment and of the intelligence community for col-
9 lection of publicly available information and commer-
10 cially available information.

11 (b) INTEGRATION WITH COLLECTION MANAGEMENT
12 SYSTEMS.—The Under Secretary shall ensure that open-
13 source intelligence collection is incorporated into the De-
14 partment’s intelligence collection management systems, in-
15 cluding systems used to manage requirements, tasking,
16 and coordination across intelligence disciplines.

17 (c) TRACKING AND ACCOUNTABILITY MECHA-
18 NISMS.—The Under Secretary shall ensure that open-
19 source intelligence collection activities are incorporated
20 into and trackable within the processes of the Department
21 for collection management and shall establish mechanisms
22 to track requirements, tasking, and performance of such
23 activities.

24 (d) INSTRUCTION.—The Under Secretary shall en-
25 sure that Department of Defense Instruction 3325.08 (re-

1 lating to intelligence collection management), or any suc-
2 cessor instruction, incorporates the requirements of this
3 section.

4 (e) IMPLEMENTATION.—This section shall be imple-
5 mented not later than 180 days after the date of the en-
6 actment of this Act.
