

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118–10
OFFERED BY MR. STEWART OF UTAH

At the end of subtitle C of title XV, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 15___. REPORT ON MODERNIZED MULTILEVEL SECURITY SYSTEM.**

3 (a) REPORT.—Not later than 120 days after the date
4 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense,
5 in consultation with the Director of National Intelligence
6 and in coordination with the Commander of the United
7 States Indo-Pacific Command and the commanders of
8 such other combatant commands as the Secretary may de-
9 termine appropriate, shall submit to the congressional de-
10 fense committees a report on migrating the classified net-
11 works of the Department of Defense and the intelligence
12 community, respectively, into a modernized multilevel se-
13 curity system.

14 (b) MATTERS.—The report under subsection (a) shall
15 include the following:

16 (1) An assessment of how to leverage commer-
17 cially available or existing Government off-the shelf

1 technology solutions to achieve the migration de-
2 scribed in such subsection.

3 (2) An assessment of constraints posed by the
4 policies of the Department of Defense and the intel-
5 ligence community, respectively, preventing the rapid
6 adoption of such technology solutions, including with
7 respect to hardware and software solutions.

8 (3) Recommendations for updating such policies
9 to grant members of the Armed Forces and intel-
10 ligence analysts access to more secure tools for the
11 rapid dissemination, integration, and storage of in-
12 formation containing both unclassified and classified
13 components (also referred to as “mixed informa-
14 tion”) from multiple networks and sources concu-
15 rrently, regardless of originating network classifica-
16 tion.

17 (4) An opinion from the Commander of the
18 United States Indo-Pacific Command (with the op-
19 tion of including an opinion from the commander of
20 any other combatant command determined appro-
21 priate by the Secretary) with respect to the level of
22 importance associated with achieving the migration
23 described in subsection (a).

1 (c) FORM.—The report under subsection (a) shall be
2 submitted in unclassified form, but may include a classi-
3 fied annex.

4 (d) INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY DEFINED.—In this
5 section, the term “intelligence community” has the mean-
6 ing given that term in section 3 of the National Security
7 Act of 1947 (50 U.S.C. 3003).
