

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-**

**33**

**OFFERED BY MR. STRONG OF ALABAMA**

At the end of subtitle B of title V, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 5\_\_\_ . PROHIBITION ON ENLISTMENT OR APPOINT-**  
2 **MENT OF FOREIGN NATIONALS FROM FOR-**  
3 **EIGN ADVERSARIES.**

4 (a) ENLISTMENT.—Section 504 of title 10, United  
5 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
6 lowing new subsection:

7 “(d) NATIONALS OF FOREIGN ADVERSARY COUN-  
8 TRIES.—Notwithstanding subsection (b), no person who is  
9 a national of a covered nation (as defined in section  
10 4872(f) of this title) may be enlisted in an armed force.”.

11 (b) APPOINTMENT.—Section 532(a) of title 10,  
12 United States Code, is amended—

13 (1) in paragraph (3), by striking “; and” and  
14 inserting a semicolon;

15 (2) by redesignating paragraph (4) as para-  
16 graph (5); and

17 (3) by inserting after paragraph (3) the fol-  
18 lowing new paragraph:

1           “(4) has not been a national of a covered nation  
2           (as defined in section 4872(f) of this title) during  
3           the five-year period ending on the date of such ap-  
4           pointment; and”.

5           (c) REVIEW OF EXISTING PERSONNEL.—Not later  
6           than one year after the date of the enactment of this Act,  
7           the Secretary of Defense shall submit to the Committees  
8           on Armed Services of the House of Representatives and  
9           the Senate a report that—

10           (1) identifies the number of members of the  
11           Armed Forces who—

12                   (A) are foreign nationals of a covered na-  
13                   tion (as defined in section 4872(f) of title 10,  
14                   United States Code); and

15                   (B) were lawfully admitted for permanent  
16                   residence (as defined in section 101(a) of the  
17                   Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
18                   1101(a))) on the date of accession to the  
19                   Armed Forces;

20           (2) identifies the date of accession to the Armed  
21           Forces of each member identified in paragraph (1);

22           (3) identifies the number of years of service of  
23           each member identified in paragraph (1); and

1           (4) identifies how many members identified in  
2           paragraph (1) are in the process of seeking citizen-  
3           ship in the United States.

4           (d) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by sub-  
5           sections (a) and (b) shall apply to the original enlistment  
6           or original appointment of a person as a member of the  
7           Armed Forces on or after the date that is 180 days after  
8           the date of the enactment of this Act.
