Amendment to Rules Comm. Print 118–36 Offered by Mr. Strong of Alabama

Add at the end of subtitle C of title XVII the following:

1SEC. 1748. SUBMISSION OF REQUESTS FOR ASSISTANCE2ALONG THE SOUTHERN BORDER.

(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Security shall make every effort to submit to the Secretary of
Defense a request for assistance for personnel or capabilities along the southern border of the United States not
later than 250 days before the requested deployment of
such personnel or capabilities.

9 (b) CONTENTS.—A request for assistance submitted 10 in accordance with subsection (a) shall specify the capa-11 bilities necessary to assist the Secretary of Homeland Se-12 curity and the Commissioner of U.S. Customs and Border 13 Protection in fulfilling the relevant mission along the 14 southern border, rather than specifying the requested 15 number of troops.

(c) WAIVER.—The Secretary of Homeland Security,
with the concurrence of the Secretary of Defense, may
waive the 250 day period referred to in subsection (a) if
the Secretary of Homeland Security—

(1) determines that doing so is in the national
 security interest of the United States due to exigent
 circumstances; and
 (2) notifies and provides reasoning for request-

ing a waiver to the congressional defense committees, the Committee on Homeland Security of the
House of Representatives and the Committee on
Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs of the
Senate not later than 24 hours after such request.
