

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118–46

OFFERED BY MR. SUOZZI OF NEW YORK

Amend paragraph (1) of section 2(a) to read as follows:

1 (1) CHINESE UNIVERSITY.—The term “Chinese
2 university” means any university or college in the
3 People’s Republic of China.

Amend subsection (b) of section 2 to read as follows:

4 (b) RESTRICTIONS ON INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER
5 EDUCATION.—Beginning with the first fiscal year that be-
6 gins after the date that is 12 months after the date of
7 the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Se-
8 curity shall ensure that an institution of higher education
9 (referred to in this subsection as an “institution”) which
10 has a monetary relationship with a Confucius Institute or
11 Chinese university is ineligible to receive any funds from
12 the Department of Homeland Security, unless such insti-
13 tution terminates such relationship. Upon such termi-
14 nation, such institution shall be eligible to receive funds
15 from the Department.

16 (c) WAIVER.—

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Homeland
2 Security may waive, on a case-by-case basis, and for
3 a period of not more than one year, the application
4 of subsection (b) to an institution of higher edu-
5 cation if the Secretary determines such wavier is in
6 the national security interests of the United States.

7 (2) RENEWAL.—The Secretary of Homeland
8 Security may annually renew a waiver issued pursu-
9 ant to paragraph (1) if the Secretary determines
10 such waiver is in the national security interests of
11 the United States.

12 (3) NOTIFICATION.—If the Secretary of Home-
13 land Security issues or renews a waiver pursuant to
14 paragraph (1) or (2), respectively, not later than 30
15 days after such issuance or renewal, as the case may
16 be, the Secretary shall provide written notification to
17 the Committee on Homeland Security of the House
18 of Representatives and the Committee on Homeland
19 Security and Governmental Affairs of the Senate re-
20 garding such issuance or renewal, including a jus-
21 tification relating thereto.
