5	States shall conduct a study that—

8	(A) individuals who use multiple drugs at
9	once or in succession (in this section referred to
10	as "polysubstance use"); and
11	(B) individuals who may switch between
12	using different substances, including fentanyl,
13	heroin, methamphetamines, and cocaine (includ-
14	ing crack cocaine);
15	(2) examines how the Federal government
16	works to prevent individuals from engaging in the
17	substance use patterns described in subparagraphs
18	(A) and (B) of paragraph (1);
